 - (iv) Revised Cost-Benefit analysis of the proposal based on the report from the Chief Wildlife Warden, as (iii) above.
 - (v) Revised site inspection report from the DFO emphasizing the details of the endangered wild animals in the area and the impact of the project on it and recommending the project from both conservation and development point of view.
