In compliance of the ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 28th October 2014 it is certified that 19.5752 hectares of protected forest land proposed to be diverted in favor of National Highways Authority of India, (NHAI) for four Laning of panipat (Start from junction with Existing km of NH-44 at panipat)- to Shamli (End at its junction with Existing 39+300 of SH-12) of NH-709AD in the State of Haryana and Uttar Pradesh Package-I (km 0.000 to km 35.580) falls within jurisdiction of 7 Villages- Haiderpur, Mawibela Ahatmal, Panjeeth, Jarkhedi, Kairana, Mannamajara & Kandela in the District Shamli.

It is certified that the as per the Gazette Natification no. 115/XIV-331-50 dated 10th February, 1960, it is notified that forest land proposed to be diverted is plantation which was nontified as "protected Forest" less than 75 years prior to the 13th day of December 2005 and is located in villages having no record population of Schedule Tribes, as per the Census-2001 and Census-2011. The proposal does not involve recognised rights of primitive tribal groups and pre- Agricultural Forest dwelling communities.
