Justification regarding Non-site Specific project

The Mini Secretariat is a local unit of administrative division in India. The Mini Secretariat plays a pivotal role at Sub-Division Administration. The construction of Mini Secretariat at Jhandutta, Distt. Bilaspur will provide a single platform to various Department to work together under one roof to provide better and easier facilities to the local population w.r.t. their work. The population of Jhandutta Division is facing many problems regarding their works as the offices are located at different locations due to which more time is consumed in preparing a single certificate/document, sometimes it takes more than one day. The construction of Mini Secretariat at Jhandutta will facilitate around 89190 Nos. of people and 277 Nos. of village under Sub-Division Jhandutta.

Further, it is stated that land holdings in Himachal Pradesh is very less and land acquisition is not possible. The private land under the ownership of local people/local communities is very less and they are dependent for their livelihood on these small private land holdings and local people are not willing to provide their private land for this project and there is no other Pvt. /Non-forest land available in & around the Jhandutta area.
