

Subject: Registration Certificate for Infrastructure Provider Category-I (IP-I)

Please find enclosed herewith the Registration Certificate No. 370 / 2011 dated 23.06.2011 issued to M/s INFOTEL BROADBAND SERVICES LIMITED.

The following points should be noted for strict compliance by IP-I Provider:

- (i) The scope of IP-I provider is limited to establish and maintain assets such as Dark Fibres, Right of Way, Duct Space and Tower for the purpose to grant on lease/rent/sale basis only to the licensed Telecom Service Providers licensed under Section - 4 of Indian Telegraph Act, 1885, on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- (ii) The IP-I provider has to submit to DoT a copy of agreement entered into with the licensed Telecom Service Providers within 15 days of signing such agreement.
- (iii) Any breach of the terms and conditions given in the enclosed Registration Certificate will lead to cancellation of the registration without any further notice.

6.0 The Registered company can provide the infrastructure as stated above to any licensee of Telegraph services Licensed under section 4 of the Indian Telegraph Act 1885. The company shall, in no case, grant in any manner the infrastructure to any erstwhile Licensee whose licence is either terminated or suspended or not in operation at given point of time. In the event of any infrastructure allowed before hand, then the Registered company shall be obliged to withdraw the grant of infrastructure and to disconnect or sever connectivity immediately without loss of time and further, upon receipt of any reference from the Licensor in this regard, disconnection shall be made effective within an hour of receipt of such reference. On the question of disconnectivity the decision of the Director General Telecom shall be final.

7.0 The Registered company shall provide necessary facilities depending upon the specific situation at the relevant time to the Government to counteract espionage, subversive act, sabotage or any other unlawful activity.

7.1 The Registered company shall make available on demand to the agencies authorized by the Government of India, full access to the network for technical scrutiny and for inspection which can be visual inspection or any operational inspection.

7.2 All foreign personnel likely to be deployed by the Registered company for installation, operation and maintenance of the Registered company network shall be security cleared by the Government of India prior to their deployment. The security clearance will be obtained from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, who will follow standard norms in the matter.


7.3 The Registered company shall ensure protection of privacy of communication and ensure that unauthorized interception of messages does not take place.

7.4 The Government shall have the right to take over the equipment and networks of the Registered company or revoke/terminate/suspend the Registration of the company either in part or in whole as per directions if any, issued in the public interest by the Government in case of emergency or war or low intensity conflict or any other eventuality. Provided any specific orders or direction from the Government issued under such conditions shall be applicable to the Registered company and shall be strictly complied with. Further, the Government reserves the right to keep any area out of the operation zone of the service if implications of security so require.

7.5 Government reserves the right to modify these conditions or incorporate new conditions considered necessary in the interest of national security and public interest.

7.6 The Registered company will ensure that the Telecommunication installation carried out by it should not become a safety hazard and is or in contravention of any statute, rule or regulation and public policy.

8.0 Any breach of the above terms will lead to cancellation of the registration without any further notice.



**Sub: Compliance of the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers
(Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006-regarding**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Forest (Conservation) amendment Rules 2016 as amended on 06th March, 2017 wherein inter-alia it has been provided that:

(e) the District Collector shall

(i) complete the process of recognition and vesting of forest rights in accordance with the provisions of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (2 of 2007) for the entire forest land indicated in the proposal.

(ii) obtain consent of each Gram Sabha having jurisdiction over the whole or a part of the forest land indicated in the proposal for the diversion of such forest land and compensatory and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purposes and details of diversion, wherever required; and

(iii) forward his findings in this regard to the Conservator of Forests

(f) the entire process referred to in clause (e) shall be completed by the District Collector within the time period stipulated in these rules for grant of in-principle approval under the Act to the proposal.

(g) the Conservator of Forests shall examine the factual details and feasibility of the proposal, carry out site inspection in case the area of forest land proposed to be diverted is more than forty hectares, and forward the proposal along with his recommendations to the Nodal Office.

I am also directed to refer to references/communications received from various State Governments seeking clarification on whether FRA certificate is to be submitted before Stage-II compliance or it has been submitted along-with proposal for seeking Stage-I approval.

It is clarified that within the time period stipulated for compliance of stage-I

Sub: Clarification regarding guidelines for diversion of forest land for non-forest purpose as per the general approval, under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for laying of underground CNG/PNG and Slurry pipelines-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the representation received from the Government of Punjab through Regional Office Chandigarh vide letter no. 1-2Misc/2019-ROC dated 08.01.2020 on the above mentioned subject and to inform that the matter was considered by the Forest Advisory Committee (FAC) in its meeting held on 23.04.2020.

2. FAC observed that as per existing guidelines dated 28.03.2019, condition mentioned in Para 4.1 (f) is also applicable on the proposals mentioned in Para 4.2. It further observed that laying of underground CNG/PNG and Slurry pipelines in RoW of the existing road is an activity being taken up in forest area which is already under non forest use.

3. After thorough deliberation on the issue, FAC recommended that CA may not be levied in case of laying of underground Optical Fiber Cables (OFC), telephone lines, drinking water supply pipelines, electricity cables, CNG/PNG and Slurry pipelines within the RoW of existing roads (trench size not more than two meter in depth and one meter in width) not falling in National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries without felling of trees.

4. In view of the above, Para 4.2 of the Comprehensive Guidelines issued on 28.03.2019 may be read as:

Laying of Underground Optical Fiber Cables (OFC), telephone lines, drinking water supply pipelines, electricity cables, CNG/PNG and Slurry pipelines. General approval is accorded for taking up these projects within RoW of existing roads (trench size not more than two meter in depth and one meter in width) not falling in National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries' without felling of trees. Approval, in addition to general conditions mentioned above under para 4.1 (***except condition "f"***), subject to the following specific conditions:

- a. No tree felling is involved for the proposed work
- b. After completion of the project the area under RoW should be reclaimed suitably.
- c. UA agrees to make good of any loss to Forest/Environment.




