A proposal named **FP/UP/Approach/48167/2020** has been received by this office from **Indian Oil Corporation Ltd.** for protected forest land proposed construction of exit/Entry approach to establishment Indian Oil Corporation Retail outlet on **Banda-Baberu-Rajapur Road (S.H.-92), in Km 2.00 (Ch. 1.470-1.500) at Gata No. 708 Village-Palhari, Tahseel-Banda, Distt-Banda in Banda Forest Division Banda, District: Banda-UP.** The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated .....**4-9-2020**

On inspection of the site it is found that land required by the user agency is a RF/unclassified/ protected forest measuring **0.065348 ha.**
