

10. Details of compensatory afforestation scheme :-

1. Details of non-forest area/degraded forest area identified for compensatory afforestation, its distance from adjoining forest, number of patches, size of each patch.
2. Map showing non-forest/degraded forest area identified for compensatory afforestation and adjoining forest boundaries.
3. Detailed compensatory afforestation scheme including species to be planted, implementing agency, time schedule, cost structure, etc.
4. Total financial outlay for compensatory afforestation scheme.
5. Certificates from competent authority regarding suitability of area identified for compensatory afforestation and from management point of view. (To be signed by the concerned Deputy Conservator of Forests).

The non-forest land for Compensatory afforestation may not be insisted in this case since relocation of the village Khejuri situated close to area of Similipal Tiger Reserve. Similipal Tiger Reserve will provide 34.40 ha of forest land which would be available in the wildness area of the Similipal Tiger Reserve helping for better conservation and development of the Tiger Reserve. These land would be developed for meadow. Moreover, the villager would be benefitted over relocated outside the Tiger Reserve. They would get better opportunities for their livelihood and quality of life.
