
ORDER



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III. Technical details:- Technical details of Compensatory Afforestation Scheme are as follows:

General Details: An area of **0.35 ha** will be taken up for planting under compensatory afforestation scheme in forest compartment No. 18/Blr in a single compact block. The area will be protected by using square PCC fence posts with barbed wire fencing and by planting Chir (*Pinus Roxburghii*) species plants.

Spacing: 2.50 mts x 2.50 mts.

Species : Chir (*Pinus Roxburghii*)


Plantation Method: Nursery grown one to two years old plants of Chir (*Pinus Roxburghii*) species will be planted in the pits of size 45 x 45 x 45 cm in the selected area. The plantation will be maintained for subsequent 10 years in which beating up failures will be done. The plantation will be rain fed.

Soil and Moisture Conservation Works:- No soil conservation works like DRSM will be required

Protection (Fencing, Watch man, People's Participation etc.):- Area will be protected from grazing by erecting barbed wire fencing around the plantation site

Proposed Monitoring Mechanism:- The plantation will be monitored as per existing monitoring mechanism in the forest department. The plantation will also be monitoring by GOI representatives as per instructions


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
