SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF/DFO.

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from M/S Himprapha Hydro Power Project Pvt. Ltd. for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 2.3307 hac of forest land for non- forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forestland for construction of Lower Kupan-II Small Hydro Electric Project (4.8 M.W). The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been conducted by me on dated 25.08.2021.

2. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring 2.3307 hac.
3. The requirement of forestland as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
4. No rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
5. No protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.
6. (a) **The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.**  
(b) It has been found that the user agency has violated the provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 Indian Forest Act, 1927/ any other forest Act. A detailed report as per para 1.9 of Chapter 1, Part C of Hand –book of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is attached).

The proposal is recommended for diversion of 2.3307 hectares of forest land for the construction road from M/S Himprapha Hydro Power Project Pvt. Ltd. The project proponent/User Agency is further required to adhere to the following conditions:-

1. Ensure that no muck/debris is thrown/dumped on the forest land situated on the downhill side of the proposed side. The muck be dumped on the designated dumping sites only and its rolling down be stopped effectively.
2. Before initiating the work the dumping sites be prepared by erecting protection walls to avoid rolling down of debris to the forest situated on the downhill side of proposed road.
3. The excavation is carried out in scientific way to avoid rolling down of stone etc.
