

In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014, and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016] it is certified that 0.438 hectares of Protected forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Torrent Gas Private Ltd. Moradabad "for laying of natural gas pipeline Moradabad-Chandausi road (NH-509) L.H.S. (Old NH-93) Chainage No. 192.320 to 197.450 Km. for apporox 5.13 Km. and Badaun-Chandausi road (SH-43) L.H.S. Chainage 42.000 to 44.170 Km. for apporox 2.17 Km. in the State of Utter Pradesh" in the District falls within jurisdiction of NHAI Moradabad and PWD Sambhal village-Chandausi, Akbarpur Jamima Jarai and Maulagarh in Chandausi tehsil having no recorded population of Scheduled Tribes as per Census of India 2001 and 2011. It is further certified that :

- The Protected Forest(s) namely Moradabad-Chandausi Road and Badaun-Chandausi road involved in the above villages are plantations raised on non-forest land on or after 13th December, 1930 and were notified as PF vide notifications no(s)-1115/XIV-331-50 dated-10-02-1960.
- Therefore, these PFs neither have residing Scheduled Tribes nor have other Traditional Forest Dwellers (residing in the PFs for more than 75 years) having rights recognized under Forest Rights Act, 2006.
