	(i)	Short narrative of the proposal and Project/Scheme for which the forest land is required.	The forest land is required for the construction of proposed Ambulance road Ward No. 1, Kandi & Dugiriuni. The total length of the road is 2.340 Kms. out of which 1.946 kms of road will pass through the forest land and 0.394 Kms. will pass through private land. This road is being constructed to provide motor link to the village Eard No. 1 Kandi & Dugiriuni. The area produces Almonds, Santaroza, Potatoes and other cereal crops, the transportation of which to the market is a major problem for the farmers of the area in the absence of road connectivity. Besides this, the motor road will be helpful for the patients in case of medical emergencies. The road will cater to the needs of population of about 300 and will give a boost to the local economy for the construction of this ambulance road, 0-63-78 ha. of forest land is required to be diverted as per Khasra number wise detail given in check list-6.

Since all the beneficiary villages are surrounded by forests hence both the alignments have to necessarily pass through forest area if the primary objective of linking the village to the motor road is to be achieved.

Besides, due to increased economic activity in the area, many indirect opportunities of employment will also come up as the road link will result in economic upliftment of population of beneficiary village.

Total land required for the road is 0-74-96 ha. out of which 0-51-78 ha. is forest land for road construction and 0-12-00 ha. forest land for muck dumping total forest land required for road and muck dumping is 0-63-78 ha. and 0-11-18 ha. land is private land.
