development of other State Highways of the Core Road Network in the State through another Project, the KSHIP-II, and pursuant to the decision of Cabinet in its meeting held on 29-09-2005 & 10.11.2006 the Government G.O.No.PWD 61 EAP 2006, Bangalore, dated 25-11-2006 has approved the proposal of improvement of a road length of 3411 Kms of State Highways of the Core Road Network in the State through another Project, the KSHIP-II is provided in Annexure-1.

- 2. The roads for improvement under KSHIP-II have been prioritized based on a Strategic Option Study (SOS) which need to be undertaken in case of projects proposed for external funding.
- 3. The Review Committee constituted by Government vide order PWD/77 FTP dated: 04-04-2006, with Secretary PWD, as chairman reviewed the outcome of the Feasibility study and a total of 3411 kms of roads was prioritized. In improvement under KSHIP-II of which 3154 kms were based on the economic feasibility as well as social & environmental screening and 257 kms on the basis of unrepresented districts.
- 4. The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for 3411 kms has been prepared. All the roads slated for improvement under KSHIP-II are proposed for Upgradation?

 a min. of 2-lane carriageway with geometrical improvements. In order to most the large requirement of funds for the Project, the Government has explored

various sources of funding including International financial institutions like World Bank, ADB and also Domestic borrowing and Private sector financing. In the circumstances, 3411 kms of roads proposed for improvement under KSHIP-II are proposed to be implemented in stages depending upon the funding arrangement.

- 5. The Asian Development Bank on the recommendation of the Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), Government of India has agreed for providing a loan assistance of US\$ 300 million for the project. The loan sharing pattern and other terms of the loan are to be finalized at time of loan appraisal.
- 6. The Government issued a Government Order vide No. PWD 219 EAP 2007

 Bangalore Dated 29.03.2008 to take up improvement of road length of 863Kms under KSHIP-II with financial assistance of the Asian Development Bank.
- Asian Development Bank after reviewing the project preparedness expressed happiness about the advanced stage of project preparedness and opined that proposed loan consideration will be taken in ADB Board for execution during 2010 itself instead of 2011.
 - 8. The list of Roads selected under the Government Order has undergone revision following discussion with the Bank team and government and it is proposed to take up improvement of 633 kms of selected roads under EPC contracts with ADB finance.
- 9. The Bank Mission in their review of the project preparation in February 22-26 2010 has finalized the list of roads of 633 kms to be implemented under EPC contracts with Bank finance. ADB advised to take up priority roads based on economic analysis, less environmental impacts, involving no large land acquisition, less resettlement impacts, avoid roads passing through National Park, sanctuaries, environmental sensitive areas under ADB assistance.

- 10. The Engineering Procurement Construction (EPC) contracts are regular International Competitive Bidding (ICB) item rate contracts without post construction maintenance and the ADB is expected to fund 80% of the contract cost.
- 11. The projected overall cost of ADB KSHIP-2 at present value is around Rs. (US 5 448 Million) 2038 crores towards the Civil works, land acquisition, rehabilitation, shifting of utilities, implementation of the rehabilitation and resettlement (R & R) measures, environmental mitigation measurers, Institutional Development Strategy (IDS) related issued. The actual size of thee project will be determined depending on the loan sharing pattern, component wise breakup, other terms to be finalized in consultation with the Bank.
