A proposal has been received by this office from PMGSY Division Marwah for the diversion (under FCA-1980) of 5.9312 Ha. of forest for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Construction of road from Ikhalla Block Boundary Kishtwar to Lopara. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 12.12.2021.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 5.9312 ha.

Moreover due to construction of this road accessibility in far flung Kishtwar High altitude would be possible.
