Furthermore, The Muck Disposal Plan must also mention additional precautions that must be taken in the event of muck spills.	Corrected & uploaded by User Agency.
2.	CA site needs to be revised and only degraded forest land up to 40% vegetation density be proposed for the CA	New CA site in Co. 38b/Dachhan has been prepared and uploaded in Additional Documents in Part-II
3.	Site specific intervention for habitat improvement and types/number of structures involved in animal passage plan along with estimates from the CWLW.	A complete plan for safe passage of animals passing has been prepared with provisions of all the essential needs by the User Agency and stands uploaded.
4.	Revised Cost-Benefit analysis of the proposal based on the report from the Chief Wildlife Warden, as (iii) above.	Corrected & uploaded by User Agency.
5.	Revised site inspection report from the DFO emphasizing the details of the endangered wild animals in the area and the impact of the project on it and recommending the project from both conservation and development point of view.	Revised site inspection report uploaded in Additional Documents in Part-II
