The Project envisage the use of forest land for construction of Approach road to new retail outlet located at Delhi-Kanpur Road KM 60 (Chainage 59.180) on the Right hand side at Khasra no. 165 Village- Lalpur, Tehsil- Sikendrabad Distt.- Bulandshahr. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated- 16.08.2022

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected forest measuring 0.1689245 ha.
