

Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is requested that 3.254935 Ha of forest land proposed to be diverted in favor of General Manager (P), National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) for Construction and Upgradation of road from design Chainage 31.449 (Khellani, Pariyot) to Km 51.700 (Prem Nagar) (Design length 20.251 Km.) in the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir Package-1 of National Highway Number -244 in Doda district falls within jurisdiction of Jangalwar, Sohanda, Kehlote, Bhadra, Shaja, Thalela villages in Doda tehsils.
