Terms and conditions

1. The applicants shall maintain good house keeping both within factory and in the premises. All hose pipelines valves, storage tanks etc. shall be leak proof. In plant allowable pollutants levels, if specified by State Board should be met strictly.
2. The applicant/company shall comply with and carry out directive/orders issued by the Board in this consent order at all subsequent times without negligence of his /its part. The applicant/company shall be liable for such legal action against him as per provision of the law/act in case of violation of any order/directives. Issued at any time and or non compliance of the terms and conditions of his consent order.
3. The applicant shall make an application for grant of consent at least 90 days before the date of expiry of this consent.
4. Necessary fee as prescribed for obtaining renewal consent shall be paid by the applicant alongwith the consent application.
5. If due to any technological improvement or otherwise this Board is of opinion that all or any of the conditions referred to above required variation (including the change of any control equipment either in whole or in part) this Board shall after giving the applicant an opportunity of being heard vary all or such condition and there upon the applicant shall be bound to comply with the conditions so varied.
6. The industry shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages, discharge of any pollutants gas/liquids from the vessels, mechanical equipment etc. which are likely to cause environment pollution.
7. The industry shall comply noise pollution (Regulation and control) Rules, 2000.
8. The industry shall comply all the direction/Rules/Instructions as may be issued by the MOEF/CPCB/HSPCB from time to time.
9. The industry shall ensure that various characteristics of the effluents remain within the tolerance limits as specified in EPA Standard and as amended from time to time and at no time the concentration of any characteristics should exceed these limits for discharge.

10. The industry would immediately submit the revised application to the Board in the event of any change in the raw material in process, mode of treatment/discharge of effluent. In case of change of process at any stage during the consent period, the industry shall submit fresh consent application alongwith the consent to operate fee, if found due, which may be on any account and that shall be paid by the industry and the industry would immediately submit the consent application to the Board in the event of any change during the year in the raw material, quantity, quality of the effluent, mode of discharge, treatment facilities etc.
11. The officer/official of the Board shall reserve the right to access for the inspection of the industry in connection with the various process and the treatment facilities. The consent to operate is subject to review by the Board at any time.
12. Permissible limits for any pollutants mentioned in the consent to operate order should not exceed the concentration permitted in the effluent by the Board.
13. The industry shall pay the balance fee, in case it is found due from the industry at any time later on.
14. If the industry fails to adhere to any of the conditions of this consent to operate order, the consent to operate so granted shall automatically lapse.
15. If the industry is closed temporarily at its own, they shall inform the Board and obtain permission before restart of the unit.
16. The industry shall comply all the Directions/ Rules/Instructions issued from time to time by the Board.

HARYANA STATE Specific Conditions :

1. That unit will comply with the directions of Hon'ble NGT order 11.11.2022 in OA No. 10/2021 titled as Sanjay Kumar Vs Union of India & will also deposit the final compensation to be determined and levied by the board for past violations as per directions of the Hon'ble NGT.
2. The unit will comply with provision of all applicable Acts/Rules/Direction of the Board / CPCB/ NGT/CAQM along with general conditions of the board.
3. The unit will maintain its APCM / dust suppression system in well working condition.
4. Unit will comply all the prescribed air emission standards under the provisions of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 amended from time to time.
5. Unit will procure water for sprinkling from approved source and will maintain log book for the same.
6. Unit will obtain connectivity of data of CAAQM Station installed at site with HSPCB Server.
7. The proponent shall maintain online ambient air quality monitoring system and submit its compliance report in this office as per conditions of environment clearance.
8. CTO so granted is without prejudice to the any violation caused by unit in past and will be deemed cancelled on account of any such observation.
9. The unit will abide by all the directions / orders issued from time to time by all the court i.e. District Courts, Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh, Hon'ble NGT and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India w.r.t. mining projects.
10. Unit will deposit balance CTO fee if found pending at on later stage as per prescribed schedule and excess amount deposited will be considered at the time of next renewal of CTO application.

11. The unit will plants sufficient Nos. of trees within & outside the premises during coming monsoon season as per approved mining plan.

12. The unit will comply all the conditions of Consent to establish/consent to operate so granted.

13. The standards prescribed under environmental laws by MoEF&CC/ CPCB are followed by the Board. Further, it is clarified that the standards to be prescribed from time to time under environmental laws by MoEF&CC/CPCB shall also be deemed to be the standards of Board. Provided that in case any stringent parameters will be prescribed by the Board on any subject where upon parameters are also provided by MoEF&CC/CPCB, the standards prescribed by the Board will be followed. The general standards prescribed under EP Rules, 1986 (as amended) shall be applicable on the industries for which specific standards are not prescribed.

14. Grant or renewal of CTO does not prevent the Board from revoking of those CTO including taking appropriate action against those defaulting units, where CTE or CTO has been obtained or got extended on the basis of wrong declaration or false documents and also who fail to comply with any of the conditions of CTE/CTO granted to such units or any relevant provisions of Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 beside forfeiture of performance security deposited by the unit for obtaining CTE & on refusal of CTO.

15. The unit will strictly comply with all the conditions of EC granted by MoEF&CC, CTE & CTO granted by the Board and in case of non compliance of the conditions, the CTO shall be revoked without giving any more opportunity.
