The Ecological class - V includes the Forest type found in the Forest being

diverted for the above titled Project. The average density of the Forest is 0.09 i.e. Open

Forest.

As per letter of the Govt. of India, MoEF&CC referred above, the Net

Present Value of Rs. 10,05,210/- has been fixed per hectare for the Eco - Class - V, Open

Forest, hence the total value works out to be Rs. 4,55,360/- (Rupees four lakh fifty five

thousand three hundred sixty) only for 0.453 hectare of Forest land being diverted.
