Suitable protection structures shall be included in the proposed road is having steep gradient to avoid soil erosion.4. Tree felling should be done in the presence of local forest officer and large trees having wildlife importance shall not be disturbed.5. Adequate number of rumblers / speed breakers and underground passages shall be provided to facilitate movement of wildlife and to avoid accidents.6. All the material required for road work shall be brought from outside and no material shall be collected from Reserve forest or reserve land.7. For any kind of blasting and quarrying prior permission shall be obtained.8. All DGPS surveyed points shall be clearly demarcated on the field and proposed alignment shall be followed.
