	Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons.	:	The road is recommended (5.5 m) in view of the importance from the point of view of the movement of the security forces to control Left Wing Extremism, subject to taking up mitigation measures by the user agency and minimize damage to this important tiger habitat. The speed breakers at every 500 Mtrs shall be constructed and speed limit (30Km/hour) shall be maintained by the User Agency. Signages shall also be fixed by the User Agency at locations given by forest department to create awareness regarding protection of the forests and to prevent human- animal conflict. Although in this short stretch falling in Mancherial District there is no need of animal passages. However, the animal passages on this route shall be provided for the movement of wildlife wherever required.
