In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) Government of India's letter no. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 03-08-2009 and dated 05-02-2013 where in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forestry purposes. In further modification of above said letters, (MoEF) exempted the requirement of initiation and completion of process for recognition and vesting of forest rights of scheduled tribes and other traditional forest Dwellers in case of Non Linear Projects vide ministry of environment and forest (MoEF) Government of India's letter no.11-9/98/FC (pt.) dated 28-10-2014.

In compliance of Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) Government of India's letter.No. 11-9/98-FC(pt.) dated 28-10-2014, It is certified that an area of **0.075028 hectare of Protected forest area situated Alongwith Basti-Dumriyaganj marg in Village Malpurwa, Pragna-Rasoolpur, Tehsil-Bhanpur, District-Basti** "Plantation notified as Protected Forest proposed to be diverted in favour of (name of user agency) Bharat Petroleum Corporation limited Gorakhpur. Provincial Office District-Gorakhpur (purposed for diversion of Protected forest) for Exit/Entry Retail Outlet.

It is further certified that the proposal does not involve Recognized Right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre Agriculture communities and the Plantations is declared Forest Land on Gazette Notification No. 96AF/XIV-196-9 dated 17 feb 1940, it is notified as "Protected forest" less than 75 years prior to the 13th day of December 2005 and are located in **Village Malpurwa, Pragna-Rasoolpur, Tehsil-Bhanpur, District-Basti** having no recorded population of Scheduled Tribes, as per Census-2001 and the census-2011.
