No. 115/XIV-331-50- Whereas the Government, Uttar Pradesh is of the opinion that the making of enquiry and record contemplated under sub-section (3) of section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act No. XVI of 1927), will occupy such length of time as in the nature of things to endanger the rights of the State Government. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions of the said sub-section and by sub-section (1) of the said Act, the Government is pleased to declare that ending such enquiry the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act to be applicable to the land specified in the schedule hereto.

No. 41/XIV - Whereas the Governor, Uttar Pradesh, is of the opinion that the making of enquiry and record entered under sub-section (3) of section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act No. XVI of 1927), will occupy such length of time as in the meantime to endanger the rights of the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the aforesaid sub-section and by sub-section (1) of the said section, read with section 80-A of the aforesaid Act, he is pleased to declare that pending such enquiry and record, the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act to be applicable to the lands specified in the Schedule hereto :-
