Sub: Works – (R&B) NH Division, Vijayawada – Rehabilitation and Upgradation of NH 565 from Km 133.922 to 154.900 to two Lanes with paved shoulder in the State of Andhra Pradesh under NHDP-IV – Diversion of 54.00 Ha of Forest land – falling in Muthukur and Markapur RF, Markapur WL Division - Diversion area revised to 38.6 Ha - RoFR Certificates falling in Prakasam and Palnadu Districts - Information – Furnished - Regarding.

It is to submit that Detailed Project Report was prepared for the subject work "Rehabilitation and Up gradation of NH 565 from Km 133.922 to 154.900 to two Lanes with paved shoulder in the State of Andhra Pradesh under NHDP-IV". This stretch falls in Prakasam District and Palnadu District.

In the ref 5<sup>th</sup> cited, I am directed by Regional officer, MoRTH Vijayawada to make correspondence for the proposal of subject work.

In this regard it is to inform that Collector and District Magistrate Prakasam District has issued RoFR certificate (Form – I) for the stretch falling in Prakasam District where in a RoFR certificate was issued stating that there were no RoFR pattas issued. After revision of diversion area from 54.00 Ha to 38.6 Ha the same certificate holds good. (Copy enclosed)

In the ref 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Collector & District Magistrate, Guntur District, Guntur has issued RoFR certificate (Form – I) for 30mts ROW certifying that 54.00 Ha of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer, NH Division, Vijayawada for the above subject

project work in Guntur District passing through Kunkuduchettupenta H/o Mittamedapalli: Siluvakonda and Davupalli Villages in Veldurty Mandal.

After reorganizations of Districts in Andhra Pradesh vide G O in the ref 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the part of the stretch falls in Palnadu District (Guntur District before bifurcation of Districts) and the present proposals involve the recognized Forest Rights of primitive tribal groups and preagricultural communities. The rights of 23 Tribals (of which 20 are PTGs i.e., Chechus) on agriculture land granted under RoFR Act is getting affected. Also the rights of 18 individuals (of which 10 are PTGs i.e., Chechus; 4 are STs (Sugali) and 4 are BCs) on House sites granted under RoFR Act is getting effected, besides of drinking water bore wells & 1 bore well with motor getting effected.

For revised ROW i.e., for 38.60 Ha revised proposals are prepared and the Collector & District Magistrate Palnadu has issued revised RoFR certificate (Form –I) certifying that an extent of 38.6 Ha of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer (R&B) NH Division, Vijayawada and the revised proposals does not involve recognized right of Primitere Tribal Groups and Pre-agriculture communities. The revised RoFR certificate is here with submitted for favour of taking further necessary action.
