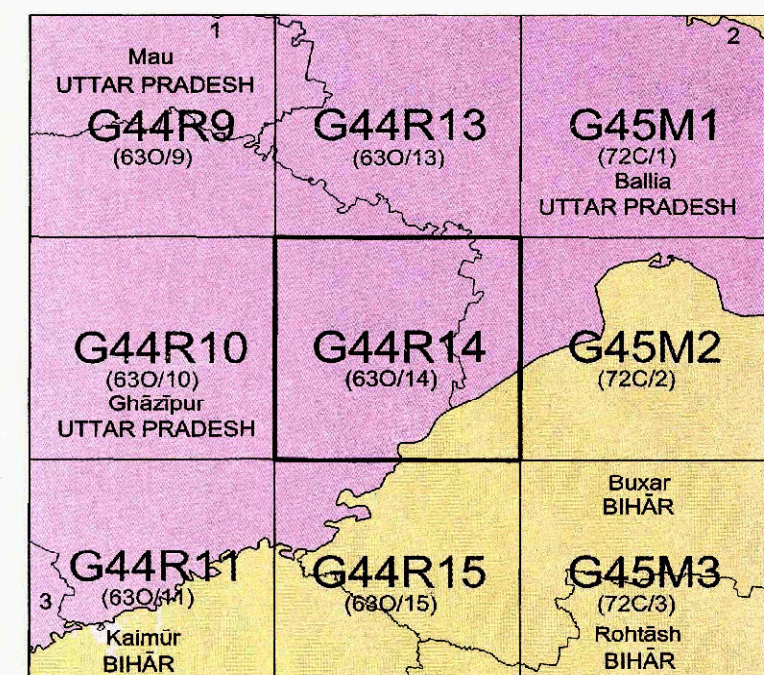

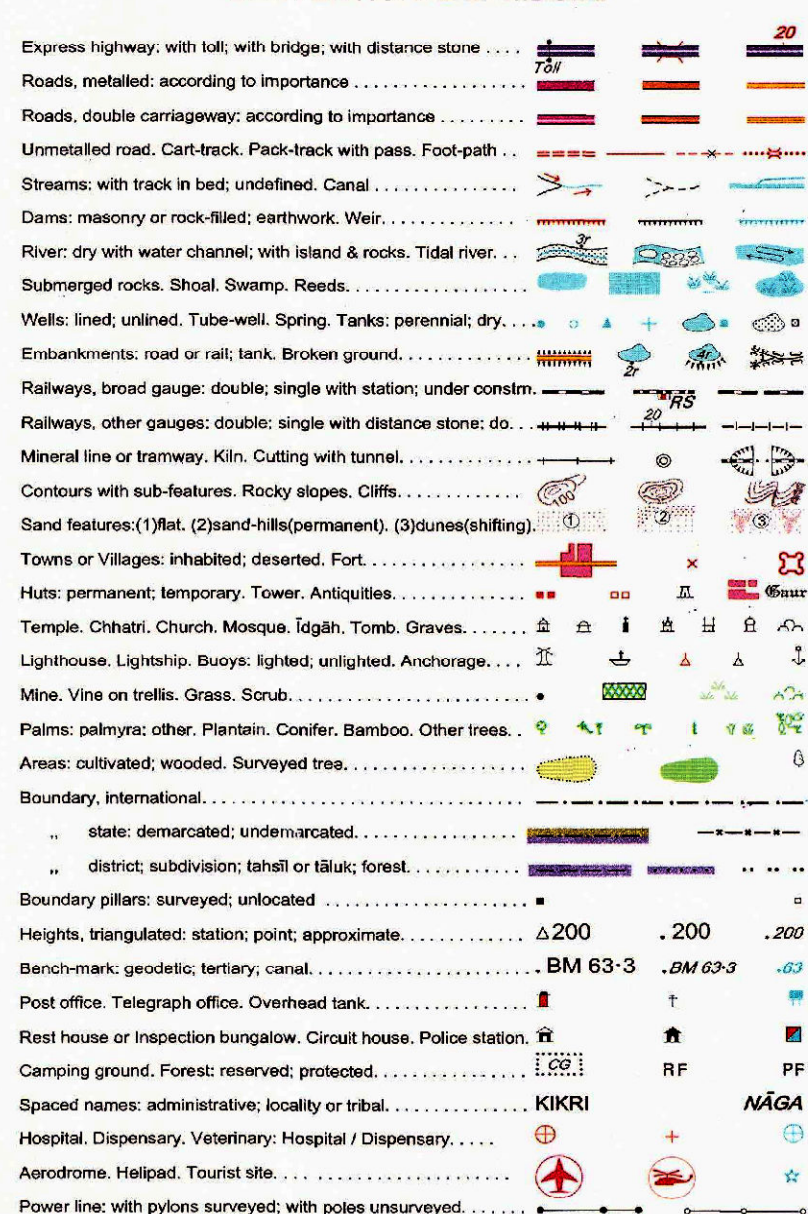

Unmetalled road exists along Buxar Canal in this sheet. Permission to use road is required from the Irrigation authorities.

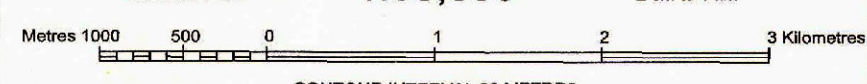
