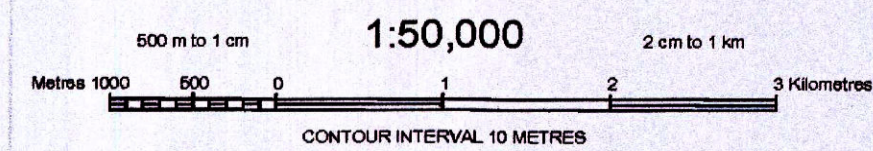

 Tanks, shown dry, in the area usually contain water from July to December.
 Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
 Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally not shown in dry season. Permission to use these along canal is required from the Irrigation authorities.
 A relative height, e.g., 80, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
 The kilometre stone numbers along the railway, road and canals are shown in slight type e.g., 5, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g., 5.
