

The Following Observations are found in the Proposal No. FP/RJ/MIN/149012/2021 Dated 24.08.2022 and Compliance which need to be replied or rectified by user agency

S.No.	Observations	Compliance
1	The DCF Bharatpur had recommended that no mining should be allowed in 15.30 ha. Area which falls inside Eco-Sensitive Zone of Bandh-Baretha Wildlife Sanctuary and accordingly the proposal was recommended by the state Govt. However, Now it has been informed that the boundaries of Eco sensitive Zone of bandh Baretha Wildlife Sanctuary are being modified. In view of this, the State Govt. Is requested to clarify the position along with a copy of Notification of Eco Sensitive Zone.	उक्त बिन्दु का जवाब कार्यालय उपवन संरक्षक भरतपुर से अपेक्षित है।
ii	Integrated Regional Office (IRO) Jaipur in SIR has pointed out that the proposed CA area is not of very good quality as per Ministry's Guideline dated 13.07.2022 and only 200plants/ha can be planted on this area. Further it has been mentioned that in order to accommodate 1000 plant for each hectare of CA plantation in addition to 248.5515 ha. Area an additional area of 994.206 ha(248.5515ha X 4) can be utilized from the remaining 4582.809 ha which is already available at the same location. Inview of this, the State Govt. Shall revisit the proposal CA site and ensure that the same are in accordance with the Ministry's guidelines issued vide Letter No. 11-423/2011-FC dated 13-07-2022. The CA scheme approved by the competent authority is accordingly required to be submitted.	उक्त बिन्दु का जवाब कार्यालय उपवन संरक्षक भरतपुर से अपेक्षित है। 

iii	IRO Jaipur has also reported that the proposed CA areas comprising Kankanchal and Adi Badri hills in Bharatpur District forms part of important Brij Churashi region, which is main center of the Krishna Circuit of the Hindu Pilgrimage. State Govt. Shall examine the impact of the same on proposed CA areas and ensure that it does not adversely affect the continuity and compactness of the CA areas.	उक्त बिन्दु के कम में Undertaking संलग्न है।
iv	The State Govt. Has not yet uploaded the kml file of safety zone on PARIVESH portal. 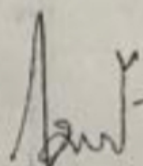
