


Land Handing Over Certificate for 1.73 Ha area of Khoraghat-3 Well inside Khoraghat GGS -1

Certificate of handing over physical possession of land





Sub: Diversion of forest land for drilling of oil by ONGC for their location Khoraghat in Golaghat Division.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.FRS.191/89/90 dated 8.12.89 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Cons) Act, 1980.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Govt. the Central Govt. hereby conveys its approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Cons) Act, 1980 for diversion of 4.73 ha. forest area for drilling for oil exploration by ONGC at location Khoraghat in Golaghat district subject to following conditions.

1. Legal status of the land will remain unchanged.
2. Compensatory afforestation to be raised in 4.73 ha. of non-forest at Silchar in Cachar district as identified by State Govt. The land identified for this purpose should be handed over to Forest Deptt. and notified as protected forest before the release of forest land being diverted by this order.
3. In order that the construction labour and staff while working on the project in the forest area may not cause destruction to the forest area, the user agency will establish fuelwood depots, and will provide the fuelwood to them free of cost.
4. Forest area to revert back to the Forest Deptt. when not required for oil drilling purpose.
5. Environmental pollution safeguards have to be strictly enforced as prescribed by the State Board for Prevention & Control of water and Air Pollution.
