National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL), under the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, proposed for diversion of 50.51 ha of forest land in the state of Manipur for implementing widening and improvement of 65.80 km section of Imphal - Moreh road (NH-39) from Lilong to Khongkhang. The project requires Forest Clearance under FCA, 1980 and a proposal for seeking Forest Clearance was applied on 09.08.2016 by NHIDCL.

The proposal received the "In Principle Approval" on 14.12.2017 under Section 2 of the FCA, 1980 vide RO-NE, MoEF&CC, Govt. of India F.No. 3 MN C 016/2017-SHI/2648-49 (Copy Enclosed as "Encl. 01").

NHIDCL has paid the demanded Compensatory Afforestation amount and Net Present Value on 30.01.2018 and received the Working Permission for felling of trees and commencement of work from Government of Manipur on 23.02.2018 vide Under Secretary (Forest & Environment), Govt. of Manipur Order no. 27/7/2017-For&Envt (Copy Enclosed as "Encl. 02").

NHIDCL has fulfilled all the conditions given by RO-NE, MoEF&CC vide "Encl.01" and Government of Manipur vide "Encl.02". The details has been incorporated under the "CHAPTER : STATEMENT OF CONDITION FULFILLMENT" included in this report.

## Students' body calls for extension of NRC to other NE states

**SHILLONG/AIZAWL/AGARTALA/KOHIMA/ITANAGAR/IMPHAL:** While Assam's neighbours were on their toes on Monday to thwart possible infiltration of people who were left out of the NRC final draft, a prominent students' body of the region called for extending the citizens' register to the other north-eastern states.

The final draft of the National Register of Citizens (NRC) was released in Assam today.

Lauding the Assam government for its achievement in preparing the draft NRC, the North East Students' Organisation (NESO), an umbrella body of students of all the north-eastern states, demanded that the exercise be extended to the other states in the region as well as they too faced the illegal immigration problem.

NESO chairman Samuel Jyrwa said, "The NRC was one of the demands after the Assam Accord. Now, we desire that it should be extended to all the north-eastern states."

He added that the other north-eastern states also suffered due to illegal immigration.

The Meghalaya government held a high-level meeting to take stock of the situation along its border with Assam, officials said.

The deputy commissioners and superintendents of police were asked to keep a close watch on the development in close coordination with their counterparts in

## 'Around 1000 immigrants tried entering Meghalaya'

**SHILLONG:** The repercussions of NRC draft published in Assam on July 30 is having its spill over effects in bordering states and Meghalaya is certainly one of them. Not even a day after the NRC draft was published, reports of infiltration have begun to emerge from Assam's neighbouring state Meghalaya.

In order to check influx, Meghalaya's Khasi Students' Union (KSU) has set up infiltration check gates in various check points at Ri Bhoi, East Jaintia Hills and West Khasi Hills. It was also informed that trucks were apprehended from these places and hundreds of outsiders

Assam, state Additional Chief Secretary (home) Peter Ingty told PTI.

The meeting was chaired by Chief Secretary Y Tsering and attended by Ingty, Home Commissioner S Kharlyngdoh and Director General of Police (DGP) Swaraj Bir Singh, the officials said.

Ingty said there was no untoward incident reported so far and the state government had taken precautionary measures to prevent any breakdown of law and order, especially in the districts bordering Assam.

"We are undertaking a tight vigil and action will be taken against any trouble-monger or alleged infiltrators," the DGP said.

Garo Hills has been kept on high alert

The Mizoram government did not sound any security alerts in view of the publication of the final draft of the NRC in Assam, a senior state police official said.

Nagaland, which shares one of the longest borders with Assam, has also been kept on high alert. The Nagaland police has deployed additional forces in the border areas, including Indian Reserve Battalion (IRB) units, Chief Secretary Temjen Toy said.

Six districts of the state --- Kohima, Dimapur, Mokokchung, Wokha, Mon and Longleng --- shared the border with Assam, he said, adding, "We are keeping a close watch on any possibilities of influx."

The state government had also written to the village councils, asking them to remain vigilant and not to allow illegal immigrants to enter their areas or employ them in any manner, he said.

Meanwhile, security was beefed up in Tripura, along its 100-km border with Assam's Karimganj district.

The Opposition CPI-M said it was against the revision of the NRC in Tripura, while the ruling BJP said it did not see any possibility of Assam's NRC revision affecting Tripura's demographic balance.

State CPM secretary Bijan Dhar said his party opposed the NRC revision in Tripura, adding that they had earlier clarified their stand on the issue.

In Manipur, police are on the lookout for bamboo structures over the Barak river, which could be used by the immigrants to cross over to the state.
