Sub: Forests - Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 - Trichy Circle / Pudukkottai Division - Proposal (FP/TN/OFC/118876/2021) for diversion of 0.0069 ha. of forest land for laying underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) in Vaiyampatti to Konnaiyur route through forest areas of Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest to a distance of 228.60m for providing 4G wireless Broadband in Pudukkottai District in favour of the Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited, Chennai - Regarding.

I am directed to enclose a copy of the reference cited and to state that, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) in his letter cited has stated that, the Jio Digital Fibre Private Ltd., Chennai has uploaded online forest area diversion proposal under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.0069 ha. of forest land for laying underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) in Vaiyampatti to Konnaiyur route through forest areas of Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest to a distance of 228.60m for providing 4G wireless Broadband in Pudukkottai District in favour of the Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited, Chennai.

- 2. In the Part-II of Form-A, the District Forest Officer, Pudukottai has furnished the following particulars:-
 - (i) Area to be diverted for the above proposal is 0.0069ha forest land in Ammankurichy Reserved Forest to a density of zero and type of forest is Eco class-4.
 - (ii) No spontaneous or planted tree growth is available in the proposed forest area.
 - (iii) The details of wildlife present in and around the forest land proposed for diversion is Spotted deer, Peacock, python, monkey and hare.
 - (iv) The proposed area does not forms part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor, Wildlife Migration Corridor.

- (v) The proposed area is not located within Eco Sensitive Zone of the protected area notified under Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972.
- (vi) The forest land proposed for diversion is not located within 1km from the boundary of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor, and Wildlife Migration Corridor.
- (vii) No rare / endangered / unique species of Flora and Fauna found in the proposed area.
- (viii) No protected archeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.
- (ix) No work in violation of the Act or guidelines issued under the act.
- (x) No Compensatory Afforestation has been proposed as no felling of trees involved in this project.
- 3. In the site inspection report, the District Forest Officer, Pudukkottai has inspected the proposed project site in Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest on 15.12.2022 has furnished the following particulars:
 - a) The length of the Optical Fiber Cable to be laid is 228.6m to a width of 0.30m to a depth of 1 to 2m and the area proposed is 0.0069ha.
 - b) The cable will be laid on the right side of the road from Vaiyampatty to Konnaiyur across Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest.
 - c) The user agency has informed that no trees or vegetation will be felled or disturbed during the execution of the project.
 - d) About machinery to be used for excavation and its impact, the user agency has informed that earthmover will be used without disturbing the vegetation and the excavated earth will be dumped on the road side and not on the forest side.
 - e) The project is important for better connectivity of 4G net work to all the public for communication.
 - f) The user agency has informed that the excavation will be immediately closed after laying the underground Optical Fiber Cable without affecting the migratory wildlife.
- 4. In the recommendation of the project proposal, the District Forest Officer has stated that since the work is essential for improvement of better communication infrastructure (4G network) to all the people and the project does not involve felling of trees and other vegetation and it is recommended.
- 5. In the site inspection report, the Chief Conservator of Forests, Trichy has furnished the following particulars :-
 - (i) The proposed area for diversion of 0.0069ha in Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest in Pudukkottai District has been inspected along with District Forest Officer, Pudukkottai on 29.12.2022.
 - (ii) The project is important for better connectivity of 4G net work to all the public for communication.
 - (iii) The user agency has informed that no trees or vegetation will be felled or disturbed during the execution of the project.

- (iv) The user agency has informed that the excavation will be immediately closed after laying the underground Optical Fiber Cable without affecting the migratory wildlife.
- (v) There is no alternate land is available.
- 6. In Part-III recommendation, the Chief Conservator of Forests, Trichy has stated that the proposal for diversion of 0.0069 ha. of forest land for laying of underground Optical Fiber Cable along Vaiyampatti to Konnaiyur road across Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest for providing 4G wireless broadband at Pudukkottai Division is recommended, since no alternative land is available.
- 7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) has further stated that the Government of India Guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in F.No.5-3/2007-FC, dated 05.02.2009, exemption for payment of Net Present Value for underground laying of Optical Fibre Cable has been allowed, if the area does not form a part of National Park / Sanctuary and no felling of trees is involved. This project area is not declared as National Park / Sanctuary and no felling of trees involved in this project. Hence payment of Net Present Value for the forest area diversion of laying Optical Fiber Cable may not be insisted.
- 8. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) further stated that, the proposal is sent duly recommended in the part IV of Form A by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation Act) / Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 of the State of Tamil Nadu.
- 9. Based on the recommendation made by the District Forest Officer, Pudukkottai Division and Chief Conservator of Forests, Trichy Circle, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has recommended the proposal for diversion of 0.0069 ha. of forest land for laying underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) in Vaiyampatti to Konnaiyur route through forest areas of Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest to a distance of 228.60m for providing 4G wireless Broadband in Pudukkottai District in favour of the Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited, Chennai, under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for a period of 20 years and requested the Government to forward same to Government of India for obtaining the approval for the project proposal, subject to the following conditions:-
 - (i) The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged and shall remain as Reserved Forests.
 - (ii) The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet height cement concrete pillars duly numbered at appropriate places as per the directions of the District Forest Officer concerned at the cost of User Agency.
 - (iii) The Optical Fiber Cable shall be laid down 1.5m below the ground and after laying down of Optical Fiber Cable the ground should be leveled.
 - (iv) The Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future shall by charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to the effect.
 - (v) The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to Flora and Fauna in the surroundings and shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.

- (vi) The forest land shall not be used for any other purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- (vii) The lease rent should be realized from the User Agency as per G.O.(Ms).No.272, Environment and Forests (FR.XIII) Department, dated 15.04.1991.
- (viii) The period of lease is 20 years.
- (ix) The User Agency should send renewal proposal one year before expiry of lease.
- (x) The Chief Conservator of Forests and District Forest Officer may impose any other condition in the interest of conservation / protection land development of forests.
- (xi) The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal.
- 10. The Government have examined and accept the proposal (FP/TN/OFC/118876/2021) of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) for diversion of 0.0069 ha. of forest land for laying underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) in Vaiyampatti to Konnaiyur route through forest areas of Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest to a distance of 228.60m for providing 4G wireless Broadband in Pudukkottai District in favour of the Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited, Chennai, for a period of 20 years, under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and decided to forward the same to Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India for obtaining their concurrence.
- 11. I am, therefore, directed to request you to kindly obtain the concurrence of the Competent Authority and communicate the same to this Government, early.

I wish to state that the Jio Digital Fibre private Ltd., Chennai has sent a proposal under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.0069 ha of forest land for laying of underground OFC along Vaiyampatty to Konnaiyur route through forest areas of Ammankuruchi Reserved Forest in Pudukkottai District through online web portal in the prescribed format.

- 2) The User Agency has furnished following Certificates / Undertakings.
- i. Signed copy of Form A.
- ii. Letter of Authorisation.
- iii. GPS map of the proposed water supply pipelines through Ammankurichi Reserved Forest
- iv. Survey of India topo sheet indicating boundary of forest land proposed.
- v. Google map for the Forest land proposed for diversion in Ammankurichi RF.
- vi. Justification for locating the project in Forest land
- vii. Certificate of Settlement of rights under Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers under Forest Rights Act 2006 in the prescribed format obtained from the District Collector, Pudukkottai vide District Collector ROC.No.E4/2721/2021, dt. 13.06.2022.

- viii) Certificate from the District Collector regarding no other feasibility alternate alignment for the above project obtained from District Collector, Pudukottai vide ROC No. E4/2721/20212, dt. 13.06.2022.

- f) Under taking by the user agency for the payment of Net Present Value of the forest land involved.
- g) Undertaking by the user agency for the payment of Additional Net Present Value if any demand raised by the forest department.
- h) Undertaking to pay the cost along with any escalation for exploitation of trees if any available in the alignment path any for the proposed Diversion of Forest land fixed by the Forest Department.
- i) Undertaking for the payment of cost of felling of trees and transportation cost of the trees to be removed in the forest land involved.

 - ii) No spontaneous or planted tree growth is available in the proposed forest area.

- The user agency has informed that no trees or vegetation will be felled or disturbed during the execution of the project.
- About machinery to be used for excavation and its impact, the user agency has informed that earthmover will be used without disturbing the vegetation and the excavated earth will be dumped on the road side and not on the forest side.
- The project is important for better connectivity of 4G net work to all the public for communication.
- The user agency has informed that the excavation will be immediately closed after laying the underground OFC without affecting the migratory wildlife.
 - 6) In the recommendation, the District Forest Officer has stated that since the work is essential for improvement of better communication infrastructure (4G network) to all the people and the project does not involve felling of trees and other vegetation, it is recommended.
 - 7) The Chief Conservator of Forests , Trichy in his site inspection report stated that

- (i). The proposed area for diversion of 0.0069ha in Ammankurichi Reserved Forest in Pudukkottai District has been inspected along with District Forest Officer, Pudukkottai on 29.12.2022.
- ii). The project is important for better connectivity of 4G net work to all the public for communication.
- iii) The user agency has informed that no trees or vegetation will be felled or disturbed during the execution of the project.
- (iv) The user agency has informed that the excavation will be immediately closed after laying the underground OFC without affecting the migratory wildlife.
- (v) There is no alternate land is available.
- 8) In the recommendation, the Chief Conservator of Forests, Trichy has stated that the proposal for diversion of 0.0069ha of forest land for laying of underground OFC along Vaiyampatty to Konnaiyar road across Ammankurichi Reserved Forest for providing 4G wirwless broadband at Pudukkotttai Division is recommended since no alternative land is available.
- 9) In this regard, it is submitted that the User Agency has uploaded all the certificates /undertakings/details as required in this proposal.
- 10) The proposal is sent herewith duly recommended in the part IV of Form A by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FCA) / Nodal Officer (Forest Conservation Act).
- 11) The area proposed for diversion of 0.0069ha of forest land for laying of underground OFC in Vaiyampatty to Konnaiyur across Ammankurichi Reserved Forest for providing 4G wirwless broadband at Pudukkotttai Division is recommended and forwarded to the Government for consideration and to obtain approval from Government of India as the User Agency is a private company subject to the following conditions.
 - (i) The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged and shall remain as Reserved Forests.
 - (ii) The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet height cement concrete pillars duly numbered at appropriate places as per the directions of the District Forest Officer concerned at the cost of User Agency.
 - (iii) The OFC shall be laid down 1.5m below the ground and after laying down of OFC the ground should be leveled.
 - (iv)The Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future shall by charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to the effect.

- (v) The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to Flora and Fauna in the surroundings and shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.
- (vi) The forest land shall not be used for any other purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- (vii) The lease rent should be realized from the User Agency as per G.O.Ms.No.272, E&F(FR.XIII) Dept. dated 15.04.1991.
- (viii) The period of lease is 20 years.
- (ix) The User Agency should send renewal proposal one year before expiry of lease.
- (x) The Chief Conservator of Forests and District Forest Officer may impose any other condition in the interest of conservation /protection land development of forests.
- (xi) The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal.

The Government of India Guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in F.No.5-3/2007-FC, dated 05.02.2009, exemption for payment of Net Present Value for underground laying of Optical Fibre Cable has been allowed, if the area does not form a part of National Park / Sanctuary and no felling of trees is involved.

This project area is not declared as National Park / Sanctuary and no felling of trees involved in this project. Hence payment of Net Present Value for the forest area diversion of laying OFC may not be insisted.

I request that the proposal for diversion of forest land of 0.0069Ha for laying of underground OFC in Vaiyampatty to Konnaiyur across Ammankurichi Reserved Forest of Pudukottai division for providing 4G wireless broadband may kindly be considered and approval may be obtained from the Government of India for a period of 20 years.
