विषय: Diversion of 10.4162 ha Forest Land In Favour of RDSA MINING LLP For  
Opencast Marble Mining (PlotNo.02/2019) in Revenue Village- Kela Mela,  
Tehsil- Pipalkhuth, District - Pratapgarh, Rajasthan.

सन्दर्भ: शासन सचिव का पत्र क्रमांक प.1(137)वन/2022 दिनांक 18.09.2023.

महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयक शासन सचिव, वन विभाग, राजस्थान सरकार, जयपुर के पत्रांक प.1(137)वन/2022 दिनांक 11.01.2023 का आशय ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें जिसके माध्यम से राज्य सरकार द्वारा विषयांकित प्रस्ताव पर केन्द्र सरकार से वन (संरक्षण) अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा (2) के तहत स्वीकृति मांगी गयी थी।

प्रश्नगत प्रकरण में इस कार्यालय के समसंख्यक पत्र दिनांक 10.07.2023 द्वारा सैद्धांतिक स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई थी जिसकी अनुपालना उपरोक्त संदर्भित पत्र द्वारा प्रेषित की गयी है। प्रस्तुत अनुपालना के अवलोकन पश्चात्, केन्द्र सरकार उपरोक्त विषयांकित परियोजना हेतु 10.4162 हे० वनभूमि के प्रत्यावर्तन एवं 4245 वृक्षों के पातन की विधिवत् स्वीकृति (Final/Stage-II Approval) निम्नलिखित शर्तों पर प्रदान करती है:-


1. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over by the user agency.
3. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 10.50 ha non-forest land of Khasra No. 68/4, Village- Sevanagar, Tehsil- Dhariyavad, District- Pratapgarh of Rajasthan and 27.7666 ha degraded forest land in Compartment No. Sagbari (PF), Village- Kela Mela, Tehsil- Pipalkhuth, District- Pratapgarh of Rajasthan at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
4. User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to 4245 trees/minimum numbers in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
5. The boundary of the diverted forest land, mining lease area and safety zone shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost as per the directions of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
6. The User Agency either itself or through the State Forest Department shall undertake fencing, protection and afforestation of the safety zone area (7.5

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- meter) strip shall be kept within the mining lease or mining cluster, as applicable and such other areas as specified in the approved mining plan at the project cost. Area of safety zone of a mining lease shall be a part of the total area of mining lease.
7. The User Agency shall undertake mining and reclamation of the mined out area as per the approved mining plan and the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
  8. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.
  9. Land so diverted shall revert back to the Forest Department in case it is not needed for the above use after due restoration to its original status (as far as possible and to the satisfaction of State Forest Department).
  10. The User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, as applicable.
  11. The change in the layout plan of the mining lease, if required, shall be done as prescribed in the MoEF&CC Guideline F.No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018 and Chapter-5 of Comprehensive Guideline F.No. 5-2/2017-FC dt 28/03/2019.
  12. The period of diversion of the said forest land shall be co-terminus with the period of mining lease granted under the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulating) Act, 1957 or Rules framed thereunder.
  13. The trees with bird nests, reptiles and habitat of Wildlife was observed than such tree shall be treated with special care for relocation in the forest land by Forest Department at the cost of User Agency.
  14. The User Agency will not use the diverted forest land for construction of buildings and other non-site specific activities.
  15. Muck will not be disposed on forest/charagah land outside the proposed diversion land.
  16. Six feet high boundary wall shall be constructed and plantation in 10 meter strip along the wall separating the forest land and diverted land at the cost of the User Agency.
  17. Six feet high boundary wall shall be constructed along the boundary of the non-forest land (NFL) proposed for CA towards the habitation and agriculture fields to prevent encroachment at the cost of the User Agency.
  18. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
  19. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
  20. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
  21. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
  22. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
  23. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.



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24. The User Agency shall comply with all the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
25. All the conditions of **Stage-I/ In-principle** approval shall be strictly complied.
26. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.
27. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F. No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018.
28. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
