Sanction Order of the Avifaunal Management Plan for Artificial Nest with reference to the diversion of 16.2635 ha of forest land in favour of Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Ltd (JUSNL) for construction of 220 KV/DC Transmission Line from Govindpur to Dumka.

The instant Avifaunal Management Plan for Artificial Nest (referred to as "the Instant Plan" hereinafter) has been prepared by Neo Human Foundation, Hazaribag with active co-operation from DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara, DFO, Dumka and Power Grid Corporation of India Limited, Namkum, Ranchi. (referred to as "the User Agency" or "JUSNL" hereinafter) in pursuance of the Condition laid under Item no. 16 of the "in-principle" (Stage-I) approval order issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India vide its letter no. FP/JH/TRANS/19286/2016/2199 dated 18th May, 2018 for diversion of 16.2635 ha of forest land in favour of JUSNL for construction of 220 KV/DC Transmission Line from Govindpur to Dumka.

The aforesaid condition laid by the Central Government reads as follows:

16. "The user agency in consultation with the State Forest Department shall create and maintain alternate habitat/home for the avifauna, whose nesting trees are to be cleared in the project. Bird nests artificially made out of eco friendly materials shall be used in the area, including forest area and human settlements adjoining the forest area being diverted for the project."

In the above stated background, the User Agency, DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara, DFO, Dumka and Power Grid Corporation of India Limited in pursuance of complying the aforesaid condition laid by the Central Government, have prepared the instant Plan in consultation with each other. Vide his letter no 699 dated 22.05.2024 the Regional Chief Conservator of Forests, Dumka & vide his letter no 1910 dated 18.10.2024 the Regional Chief Conservator of Forests, Bokaro has submitted the plan to the office undersigned for its due sanction. While considering the plan for its approval, a Power Point Presentation was scheduled with RCCF, Bokaro, RCCF, Dumka, CCF, Wildlife, Jharkhand, CF, Dumka in the office of undersigned, on dated 27.11.2024. During the PPT certain observations were made and it was instructed to modify the plan on certain Budget points. The PPT was attended by RCCF, Bokaro, RCCF, Dumka, CCF, Wildlife, Jharkhand, CF, Dumka, Sri S.K. Choudhry, Sr Manager, JUSNL, Sri Rajeshwar Nayak, Sr. DGM, Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd, Dr Satya Prakash, Neo Human Foundation, Ranjeet Kumar, DGM, Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd and Sri Kuldip Kumar, Engr, Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. Compliance of observations made by undersigned, was submitted by the Power Grid Corporation of India Limited vide his letter no. 1982 dated 09.12.2024.

The Plan contains seven chapters including introduction, important flora and fauna, methodology, Objective and management of artificial nest for avifauna, monitoring, proposed budget and appendices. Avifauna management plan suggests "Mitigation Measures" to the actions that can be implemented to minimize the magnitude of the project related detrimental impacts on ecology in general and forest & wildlife of the project area. The activities/management interventions have been proposed in Dhanbad Forest Division, Deoghar Forest Division, Jamtara Forest Division and Dumka Forest Division. The various work components have been assigned to the implementing agencies so as to achieve the maximum efficiency in terms of output and to the best of appreciation of the needs of conservation of forests and wildlife. The summary of the proposed plan (component wise) with the objective of conservation of forest and wildlife resources as also to mitigate the impacts of the project on forests and wildlife is as follows:

The Plan with a total financial outlay of Rs 204.39 lakh (18.46 Lakhs in Dhanbad Forest Division, 59.70 Lakhs in Deoghar Forest Division, 56.21 Lakhs in Jamtara Forest Division and 70.02 Lakhs in Dumka Forest Division) for implementation of Avifauna Management Plan (AMP) extending over a period of 05 years (Year 2024-25 to 2028-29; tentatively), shall be utilized by the State Forest Department through the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka in accordance with the Plan prescriptions.

Considering the proposals under the plan, sanction is hereby accorded to the instant Plan subject to the following conditions:

- (i) Implementation of the instant Plan prepared in respect of the proposed project.
- (ii) That various activities in the project shall be executed under the monitoring and guidance of DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka in their respective jurisdiction and under the supervision of RCCF Dumka, CF, Territorial Circle, Dumka, RCCF, Bokaro and CF, Territorial Circle, Bokaro respectively.

- (iii) That the User Agency shall ensure that its officials/contractors and the work force engaged into transmission line laying and allied works shall not commit or abet any forest/wildlife offence in their area of operation. They will also promptly report any forest/wildlife offence in the area to the nearest forest office/official. Further, they will extend their full cooperation to the forest officials in control/mitigation of any incident, natural or manmade, detrimental to forest and wildlife in their area of operation.
- (iv) The essence of decisions taken by NBWL in the 66th Meeting of the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Environment Forest and climate change on 31.12.2021 and minutes circulated vide MoEF&CCF.No. 6-141/2021WL dated 1 February 2022, in the cases of management of lands of Protected Areas/forests under transmission lines (Agenda Item Nos. 3 & 5) will be followed while implementing the project and with special considerations for protecting elephants from accidental electrocution by keeping height above ground at the lowest point of the lowest conductor or grounding wires (i.e. at maximum sag point) of power lines and also to avoid electrocution to avifauna and other arboreal species.
- (v) The entire length of the proposed power line between Govindpur to Dumka should be marked with appropriate bird diverters spaced at 10 m intervals. The bird diverters shall be regularly checked and maintained by the User Agency.
- (vi) The user agency and project personnel will comply with the provisions of Standard SOP/Guidelines issued by WII, Dehradun for linear projects.
- (vii) Any felling/pollarding/pruning of trees for allowing electrical clearance/maintenance will be done with the permission of the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka in their respective jurisdictions. Only those trees that are of sufficient height to compromise the requirements of minimal vertical and horizontal clearance from the conductor wires at maximum sag point should be lopped.
- (viii) The gabion plantation of native, palatable species suitable for wild ungulates should be actively promoted by the user agency in collaboration with Jharkhand Forest Department below the power-line in order to avoid invasive species likely to come up due to periodic clearing of vegetation along the power-line.
- (ix) That the total amount of Rs. 204.39 lakh (Rupees Two crore four lakhs thirty nine thousand only) shall be deposited by the User Agency into CAMPA account only through <https://parivesh.nic.in> under the relevant head/sub-head which shall be utilized by the State Forest Department through the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka as delineated under the Plan, strictly in accordance with the prevailing norms under the Jharkhand Forest Department.
- (x) That the User Agency shall implement the mitigation measures/activities mentioned under the Plan. The implementation shall be done under the directions and strict supervisions of DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka.

- (xi) That the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka shall prepare detailed Annual Plans of Operations (APOs) in the beginning of every financial year during the Plan period, as provided in the instant Plan, following all the rules, regulations, Schedule of Rates etc. issued from time to time by the State Government/ Forest Department. RCCF, Dumka in case of DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka and RCCF, Bokaro in case of DFO, Dhanbad shall accord sanctions to the said APOs following due process and they will respectively closely monitor the implementation/progress of the activities undertaken by Dhanbad, Deoghar, Jamtara and Dumka Forest Division as per directions issued by the Forest Department from time to time.
- (xii) That the CF, Bokaro and CF, Dumka shall respectively supervise all the activities under the Plan undertaken by Dhanbad, Deoghar, Jamtara and Dumka forest division respectively as per directions issued by the Forest Department from time to time.
- (xiii) That the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka shall carry out the activities under the Plan strictly as per the duly sanctioned APOs.
- (xiv) That the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka shall ensure that no violation of duly sanctioned Working Plan of Dhanbad Forest Division, Deoghar Forest Division, Jamtara Forest Division and Dumka Forest Division takes place during implementation of any of the activities involved in this plan over notified and demarcated forest land.
- (xv) That the instant Plan is dynamic and shall be revisited after every 2 years and a revised plan may be formulated as per need of the project impacted area and convenience of the implementing agencies. The revised plan, if any, shall be put up before the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Wildlife & Chief Wildlife Warden, Jharkhand for its due approval.
- (xvi) That the User Agency shall submit an Undertaking to the DFO, Dhanbad, DFO, Deoghar, DFO, Jamtara and DFO, Dumka to the effect that they will deposit extra cost of the plan owing to increase in wage rate, cost of materials etc. in due course of time as well as consequent upon revision of the plan, if any, as and when given effect to by the competent authority.



Sanction Order of the Avifaunal Management Plan for Artificial Nest with reference to the diversion of 16.2635 ha of forest land in favour of Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Ltd (JUSNL) for construction of 220 KV/DC Transmission Line from Govindpur to Dumka.
