The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur has submitted the proposal for diversion of 12.07 ha. Forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Sakhari-Irawati (Pouni III) Opencast Mine Project.

2. The details of forest land proposed for diversion are as under: -

3. The proposal has been initiated by the Area General Manager WCL, Ballarpur Area. The project includes 766.47 ha. non-forest land. Sakhari-Irawati (Pouni-III) Opencast mine is located in Rajura Tahsil of Chadrapur district of Maharashtra State. The mine is 210 km away from Nagpur and nearest railway station is Ballarpur, which is about 20 km from the proposed project. The project would contribute 1.25 Mty. of coal per annum to bridge the ever increasing gap between demand and supply of Thermal Power Stations in India.

4. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Forest Division has certified that:-

- 4.1 no suitable alternate land is available and the forest land required is barest minimum.
- 4.2 the area belongs to Eco-value class-III having density less than 0.4 comes under Tropical Dry Deciduous Forest.
- 4.3 no tree felling involved in implementation of the Project.
- 4.4 the area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc.
- 4.5 proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archaeological or recreational importance.
- 4.6 there is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
- 4.7 the proposed area for the project is beyond 10 km from the boundary of the Protected Areas.

4.8 and proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 24.14 ha. degraded forest land in Compartment No.567 in Ballarpur Range, Central Chanda division, Dist. Chandrapur and it is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances.

5. The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-

- 5.1 agrees to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation.
- 5.2 agrees to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed under diversion.
- 5.3 the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before approval.
- 6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 7. In the circumstances explained in the aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that the said forest land may be allowed to be diverted on the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur. The matter may kindly be placed before the Government of India for its approval under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, be obtained and communicated to this Government.
