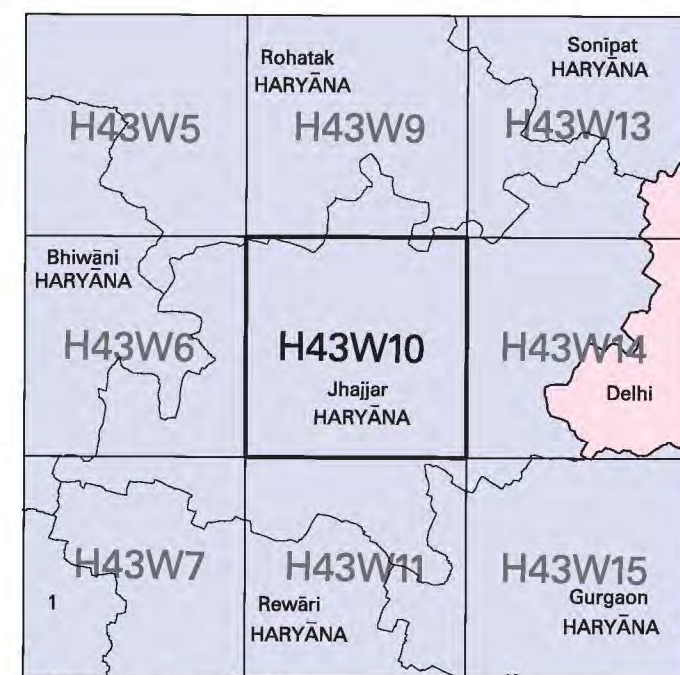

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.

A relative height, e.g. $3R$, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Important Government buildings are shown in black with names.

Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.

Tube-wells and wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.

Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in the dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.

3,000-scale resection stations of Bilakur Dam Project Surveys with their numbers are shown as
terrestrial bench-marks thus: $\triangle 123$, BM 236-1

Canal distance-meters are 1,000 feet apart and every existing Irrigation sheet is shown.

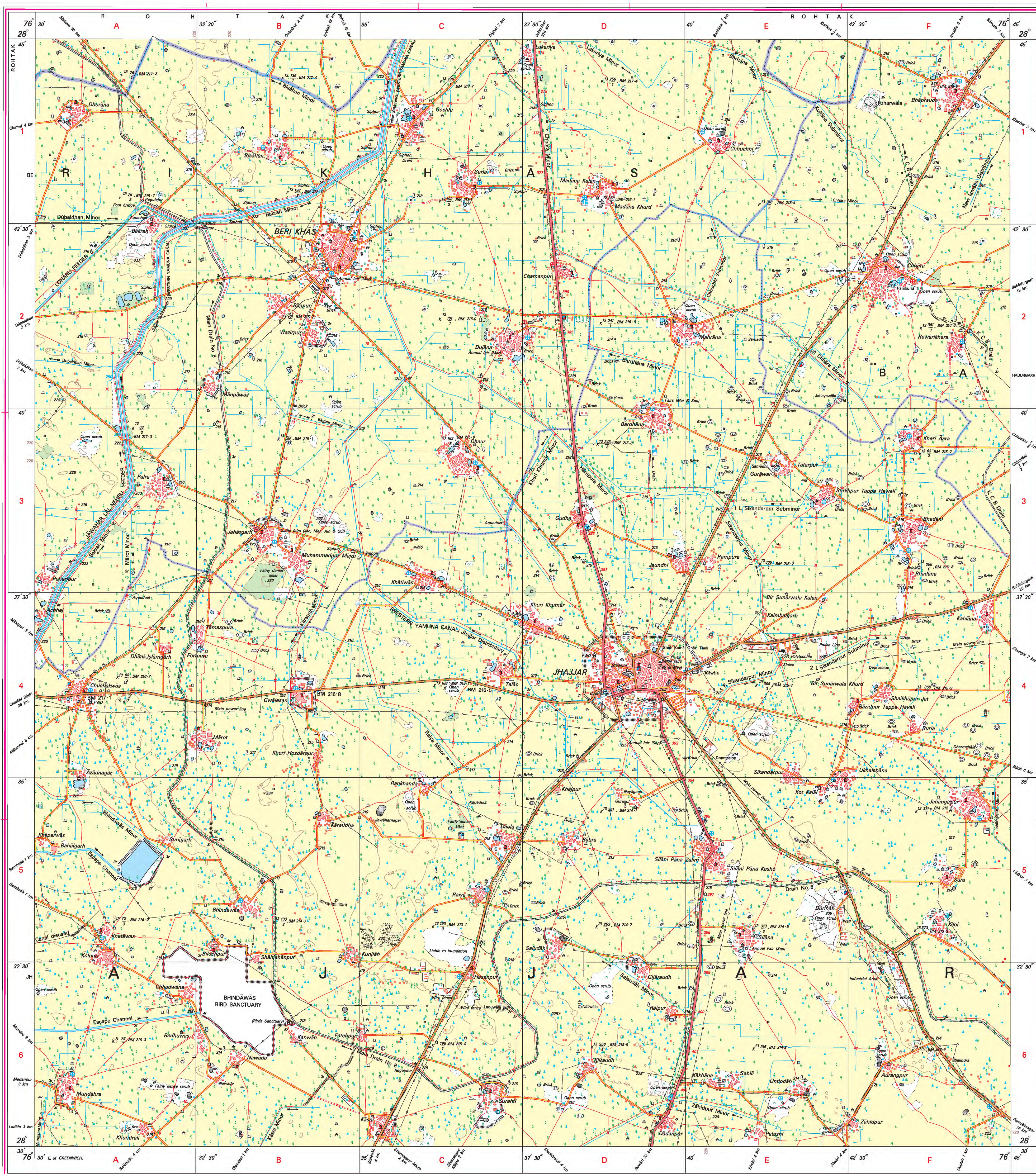
