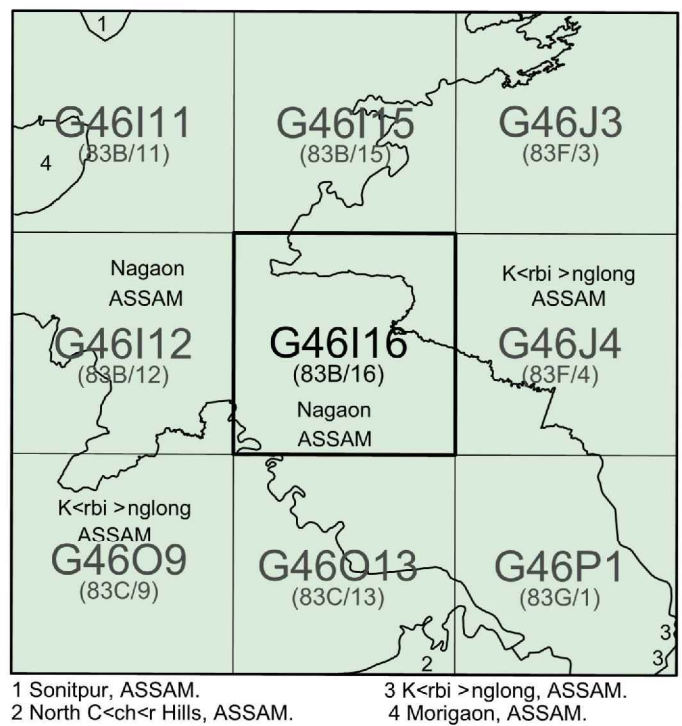

The Kapili R.F. boundary in square 67 is shown as surveyed but has not been verified by the forest authorities.
Jhum or temporarily cultivated areas occur throughout the jungle; the are normally abandoned after 2-3 years and are not shown.
