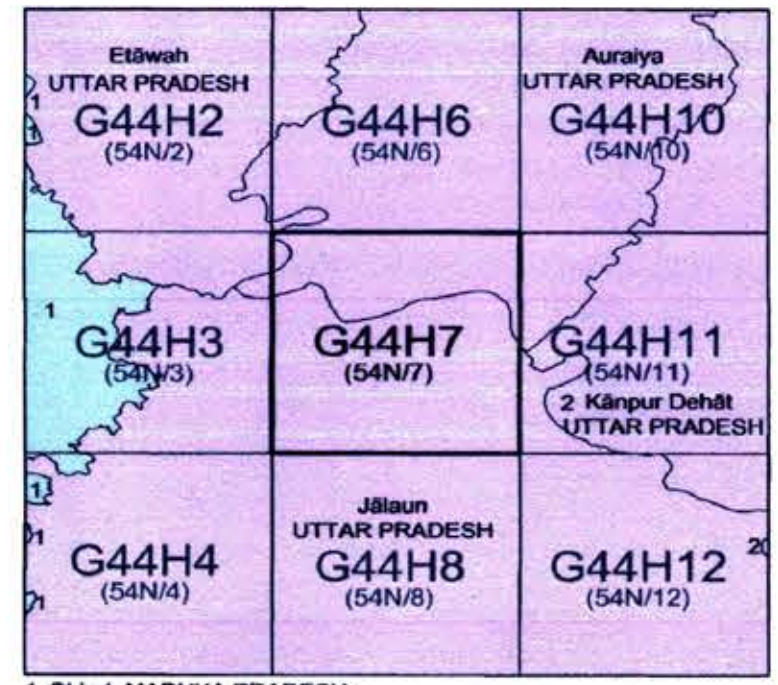

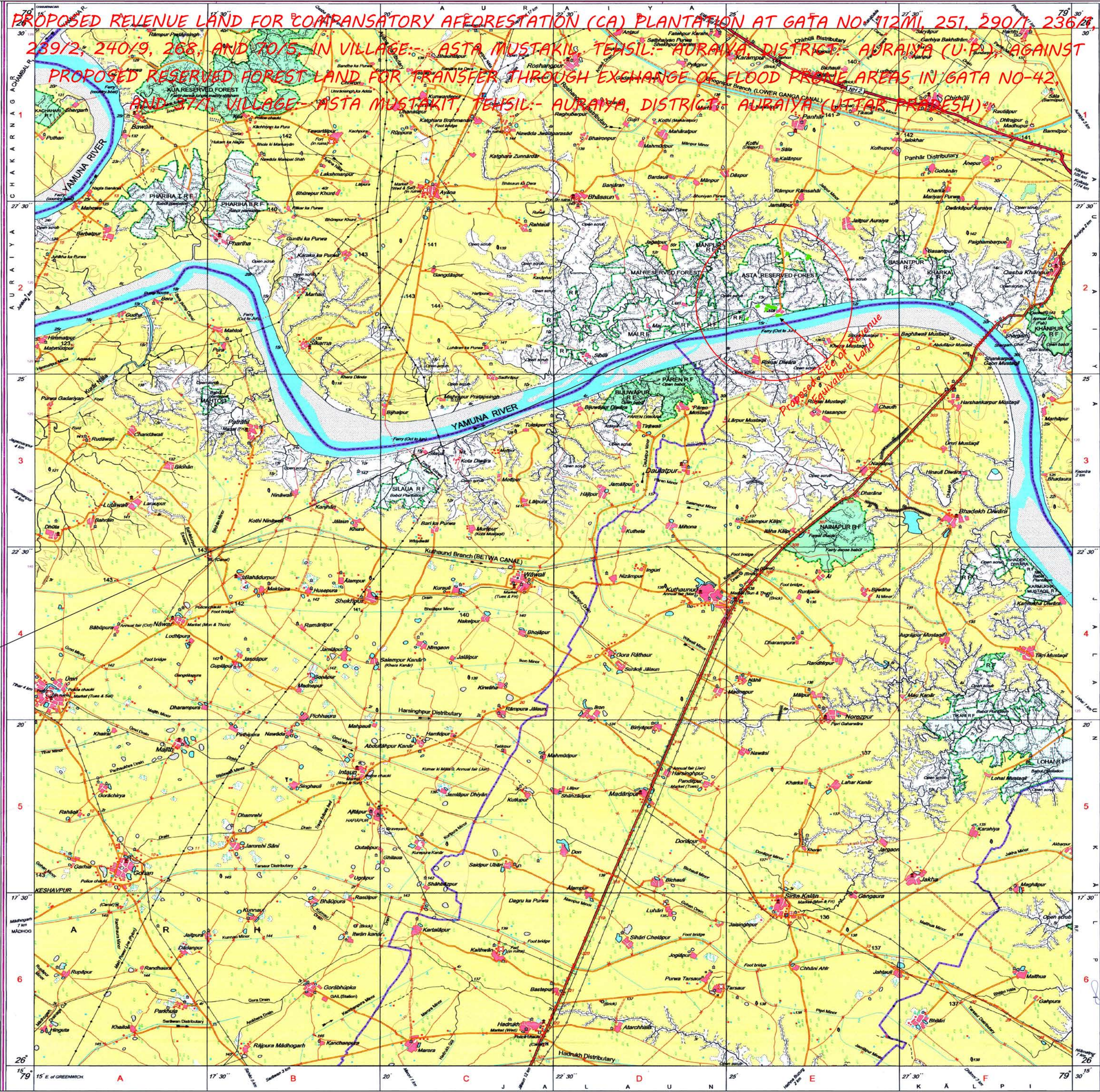
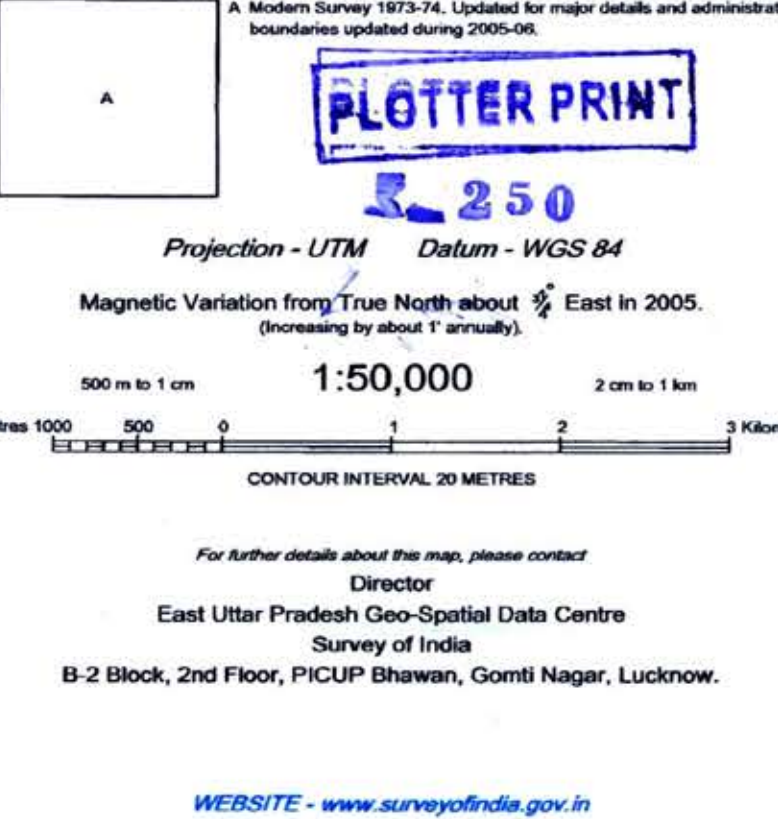

NOTES :-
Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads are shown in slant type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.
Avenue of trees exists along Bhagpur Branch (LOWER GANGA CANAL).
The unmetalled road and cart-tracks along canals are not shown in dry season whereas other cart-tracks are generally passable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
Tanks shown in this area, usually contain water from July to December.
Wells are numerous throughout the cultivated portions of this sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, e.g., 10, marked along a canal indicates the height of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
The district boundary in the Yamuna River follows the main deep water channel and will change with the fluctuations of that channel.
