In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9798-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and complete the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act. 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be delivered for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read-with MoEF's letter dated 28th October 2014 where in certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 1.3635 hectares of forest land proposed to be delivered in favour of Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited for laying of 40mm dia PLB pipe carrying 14mm OFC cable along and across the Navsari Telephone Exchange to Billimora Telephone Exchange Highway, District-Navsari.
