is from the actual value.

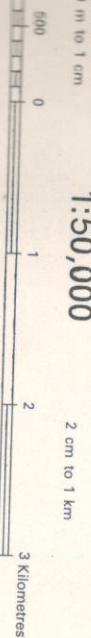
