TO WHOWSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act. 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 285.700 hectare of forest Land (Beat Mansinghpura. Compt. No. RF-154) proposed to be diverted in favor of satpuda tiger rigarve hoshangabad (name of user agency) for Relocation of forest village malni (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Betul district falls within Jurisdiction of Salimate village (s) in Sahpur tehsils District Betul.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 285.700 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the forest rights Committee (s) Betul, Gram Sabha (s), Sub-Division Level Committee (s) and the District level committee are enclosed as annexure a to c annexure.
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned gram sabha of forest dwellers, who eligible under the FRA.
- (c) The each of concerned Gram Sbha (s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Salimate village (s) is enclosed as annexure a to c annexure.
- (d) the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of gram sabha present.
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the gram sabha have given their consent to it.
- (f) The rights of primitive tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (I) (e) of the FRA.
