JUSTIFICATION LETTER FOR FOREST LAND DIVERSION

- 1. Border Roads Organization (BRO) is a department under Ministry of Defense of the Government of India. The Road Migging-Tuting is maintained and developed by BRAHMANK project of this organization. The road has been divided into two sections for developments to NHDL specification under GS (OPS)(Km 0.00 to Km 35.00). Each section of the roads is passing from forest area which are coming under Yingkiong Forest Division. Present road is very important link to Indo-China Border areas and LAC. This road is connecting district HQ of Upper Siang to Tuting. This road is used by Army for Logistic movement to line of actual control in Arunachal Pradesh. The insufficient road width and number of acute curves causes problem for smooth movement of traffic and makes it accident prone and also hampers faster movement of vehicles.
- 2. In the forest area, some parts of the project road passes from ghat sections and there are lots of small and large blind curves which creates hurdle in smooth movement of traffic and increases travel time also. Present status of this road is Class-09 specification and is not suitable according to the standard of NHDL. To avoid these type of geometric problems, the present road is being proposed for upgradation to NHDL specification for which forest land diversion is required.
