The Government of India have accorded Stage-I approval for diversion of 1.81 Ha of forest land for Rehabilitation and up gradation of NH-18 from KM 108/850 to KM 160/200 (Rayachoty to Kadapa Section) to two lane with paved shoulders in the state of Andhra Pradesh in favour of Executive Engineer, R&B NH Division, Kadapa subject to fulfilment of certain conditions.

of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project
proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in
turn has to display the same in 30 days.
