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## JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING PROJECT IN FOREST AREA

The existing road Walchandnagar- Anthurne- Shelgaon- Vyahali- Kauthali MDR 76 from Chainage Km. 25/000 to Km. 26/540 connects Industrial Town of Walchand Nagar with villages Shankar Rao Patil Cooperative Sugar Factory at Bijwadi. The workers in Sugar Factory at Bijawadi are residing mostly in the adjoining villages. The road also connects Industrial Estate at Loni.

The entire MDR 76 road, having Chainage from Km. 25/000 to Km. 26/540 is metaled, except 790.4 m. long stretch from Chainage Km. 25/000 to Km. 25/791, which is passing through a patch of Forest Land. Hence, the road is being not utilized by the stakeholders. The sugar cane transporters are using this existing kaccha thoroughfare through Forest Land when the factory is in operation. The road is also used by the farmers of surrounding villages, day to day, for transporting their Agricultural Produce. A need has always been felt for improvement (Black topping) of the forest part of the road to ensure safety of vehicles transporting the sugarcane to factory at Bijawadi and of the workers/ farmers/ bye passers.

The extant road has been included in the Road Development Plan 2001-2021 of the Maharashtra State. The Government of Maharshtra has accorded Administrative Approval for the project of improvement of the extant road. The project is also technically sanctioned by the Chief Engineer, PWD, Pune.

Since, the proposed work is to be carried out in the patch of Forest Land, the project attracts provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The project requires Forest Clearance i. e. prior approval under Section 2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 from the Central Government. The part of Forest Land admeasuring 0.71136 Ha. is required to be diverted to enable connect the entire stretch of the existing road and put it to its optimal use.

The project involves improvement (Black topping) to only the kaccha part of the existing road which is passing through the Forest land. Hence, no alternative can be substituted for the existing alignment. The project is, therefore, the site specific. The Forest Land proposed for diversion is, thus, unavoidable. The barest minimum Forest Land, to the extent of 0.71136 Ha., is required/proposed for the project.
