


CERTIFICATE

REGARDING COMPLIANCE OF SCHEDULED TRIBES & OTHER TRADITIONAL FOREST DWELLERS (RECOGNITION OF FOREST RIGHT) ACT, 2006 IN RESPECT OF DIVERSION OF FORESTLAND MEASURING AC.769.46 OR HC.311.396 (DLC REPORTED AREA) IN SILJORA-KALIMATI MANGANESE & IRON MINES OF M/S MANGILALL RUNGTA IN VILLAGE SHREE JODA(SILJORA) (AC.356.50), BALADA (AC.0.03), TADAPANI (AC.39.31) AND BADA-KALIMATI (AC.373.62) UNDER BARBIL, TAHASIL.

01. It is certified that the complete process for diversion and settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been carried out for the entire Forest area of Ac.769.46 or Hc.311.396 proposed for diversion for Siljora-Kalimati Manganese & Iron Mines of M/s Mangilall Rungta in village Shree Joda(Siljora) (Ac.356.50), Balada (Ac.0.03), Tadapani (Ac.39.31) and Bada-Kalimati (Ac.373.62) under Barbil Tahasil. The concerned record of all consultations and meetings held are annexed in shape of Gram Sabha Resolutions dt.20.03.2010 and 22.03.2010, joint enquiry report dt.31.3.2010 of Revenue & Forest Personnel.
02. It is certified that the proposal for such diversion have been placed before the Gram Sabha on 20.03.2010 at village Siljora under the Chairmanship of Sarapanch, Balada G.P. for village Siljora, Balada and Tadapani, on 22.03.2010 at village Bada-Kalimati under the Chairmanship of Sarapanch, Bada-Kalimati G.P. for village Bada-Kalimati and in presence of more than 60% of members of Gram Sabha and Members of Village Forest Committee where the details of the project and its implication have been explained to them in vernacular and English language. It is further ascertained that no eligible Forest Dwellers was found under Forest Rights Act, 2006.
03. It is certified that discussions and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was quorum of minimum 50% of the members of the Gram Sabha present.
04. It is certified on the basis of joint verification report and Gram Sabha Resolutions dt.20.03.2010 and 22.03.2010 that no such primitive Tribal Groups and pre-agricultural communities were available on the forest land proposed for diversion and whose forest rights are required to be specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006.
05. It is certified on the basis of joint verification report and Gram Sabha Resolutions dt.20.03.2010 and 22.03.2010 that no such facilities managed by Government requiring diversion of forest land u/s 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006 exist over the forest land proposed for diversion.

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.YI-942-FC(PD) dt. 3rd August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights Act), 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 148,409 hectares (139,736 Ha. of forest land ~~proposed to be diverted~~ 8.673 Ha of forest land earmarked for safety zone) proposed to be diverted in favour of M/s Mangilall Rungta for the purpose of mining activities in Siligora-Kalimati Manganese & Iron Mine in Keonjhar District falls within jurisdiction of Siligora(Ha.143.276), Badakalimati(Ha.1490), Balada (Ha.0.008), Handibhanga (Ha.2.157), Dabuna (Ha.1.25), Talipani (Ha.0.194) villages in Babil Tahasil and Nayagath(Ha.0.029) in Jhumpura Tahasil.

It is further certified that

- the complete process of identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 148,409 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District level Committee are enclosed as annexure D1 to annexure D4s
- the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha(s) of forest dwellers who are eligible under the FRA.
- the each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and the details of proposed diversion. Copy of certificates in terms of Gram Sabha Resolutions issued by the Gram Sabhas of Siligora, Badakalimati, Balada, Handibhanga, Dabuna, Talipani and Nayagath villages are enclosed as annexure D5, D12, D18, D25, D31, D37 & D43
- the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- No such facilities managed by Government requiring diversion of forest land w/s 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006 exist over the forest land proposed for diversion.
- the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (c) of the FRA.
