Shahpurkandi Barrage & Power Plant Scheme (Punjab) Clearance from
the environmental angle.

Sir,

I am pleased to inform you that the above project has been duly
considered in the Department of Environment and accorded clearance from
environment angle provided that the following safeguards are effectively implemented:-

- i) Fuel depots should be opened to provide fuelwood free of cost to the labour
force during the construction phase. Adequate financial provision to meet the
fuel requirements should therefore be made in the project budget.
- ii) To control the excessive siltation of the reservoir, soil conservation measures
should be clearly spelt out for implementation in the catchment.
- (a) Restoration of construction areas should be ensured, to the extent
possible, to prevent further erosion and to erase the scars.
- (b) Cultivation & grazing in the vicinity of the water spread should not be
permitted.
- iv) Adequate arrangements may be made to prevent the incidence of any
endemic health problem due to water/soil-borne diseases and
- v) Either a separate Monitoring Group be created to, or the Monitoring
Group already formed for the Thein Dam Project may, oversee the
effective implementation of the suggested safeguards.

Any assistance in the implementation of the safeguards, if needed, shall
be gladly extended by this office.

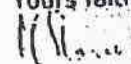
