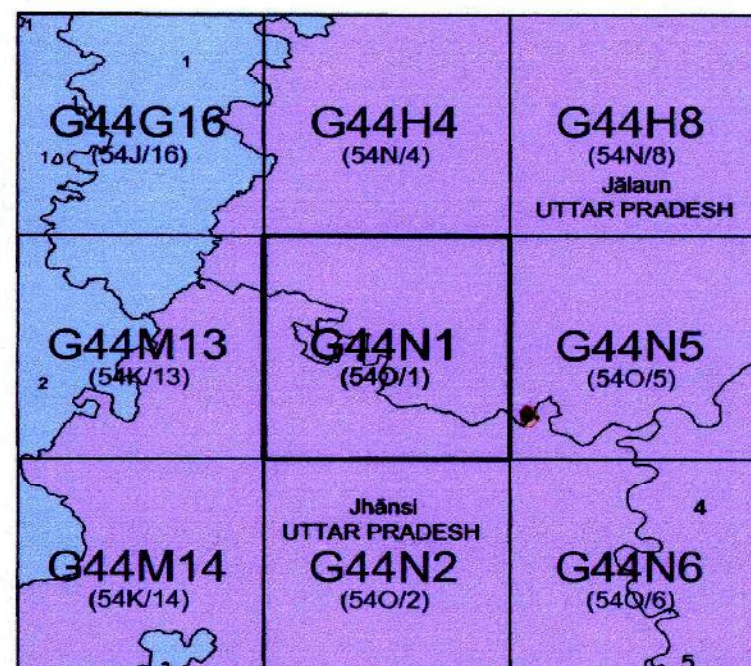

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height $\leq .5$, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in start type, e.g., '5' whereas the kilometre stone numbers in upright type, e.g., '5' are shown in the middle of the line.
Walls are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height $\geq .5$, marked along canals, indicates the height of the top of canal embankment above the adjacent country.
The kilometre stone numbers along branch canals and distributaries are shown by track-trace symbols. These and other cut-tracks along canals are generally motorable in dry season. Other cut-tracks along which there is no descriptive remark, are jeepable in dry season. Permission to use those along which no remark is required from the Irrigation Department.
Tanks, shown in this area, usually contain water from July to December.
