Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.  
Contours are approximate.  
A relative height, e.g., 350, against a well, indicates its total depth in meter.  
Unmetalled roads and cart-roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from irrigation authorities.  
The district boundaries in the Betwa and Ghaghara River follow the main deep water channels and will change with the fluctuations of these channels.  
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.  
Tide-gauge are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.  
The milestone stone numbers along railways and roads are shown in short type, e.g., 8' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 5.
