Justification for Locating the Project in Forest Area


05-79-46 Hectares of Forest Land is required for the construction of Link road Reog Dhwala Galanghatti KM 0/000 to 8/050. The total length of the proposed road is 8.05 KM. Out of this, 5.675 KM of Road passes through Forest Area & the remaining 2.375 KM passes through Private Lands. The road is being constructed to provide a motor link to Village Galanghatti. The road will cater to the needs of a population of 500 souls and will give a boost to the local agriculture-based economy. The location of the human settlements is in close proximity to the forest area and this creates a geographical necessity to use forest land for the construction of this road. Three alignments were explored for the construction of this road, details of which are as follows:

The above alignments were explored during the joint inspection of the road. Also, on examining the Survey Map of these alignments (enclosed), it can be noticed that due to the geography of the area, constructing the road avoiding the Forest Land is not possible. Moreover, the second & third alignments involve a greater road length and thus a greater Forest Area and number of Trees, thus the First Alignment was finalized for the proposed road.
