



The Construction of Residential School with Hostel, Staff Quarters, Play Ground, Approached Road, Science Laboratories and open space etc. require forest area to the extent of 0.99 ha which could not be avoided. This is the smallest and best option chosen with the involvement of forest area to the barest minimum. And, there is no alternative forest land available for its construction.

As the Residential School at Chingkhei Ching, Tinsid Road, Imphal East meant for the urban deprived children, homeless and street children in difficult circumstances and without adult protection, who require not only merely day schooling but also lodging/boarding and fooding facilities. Besides, we all know that the best academic atmosphere can be created at the location little away from Settlement areas. Hence, construction of Residential School in the forest area which is well outside/away from National Park/ Wildlife Sanctuary is justified.

Therefore, we seek to approach the Forest Department for Forest Clearance.
