- Height and contours have not been shown.
- A relative height, Δ , represents the approximate height, in meters, between the top and bottom of a mass slope.
- A relative height, Δ , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
- Tides, shown day in the sheet, usually contain water from July to December.
- Tide-gates are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
- The sea adjoining the Sarda or Chauka River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the sheet.

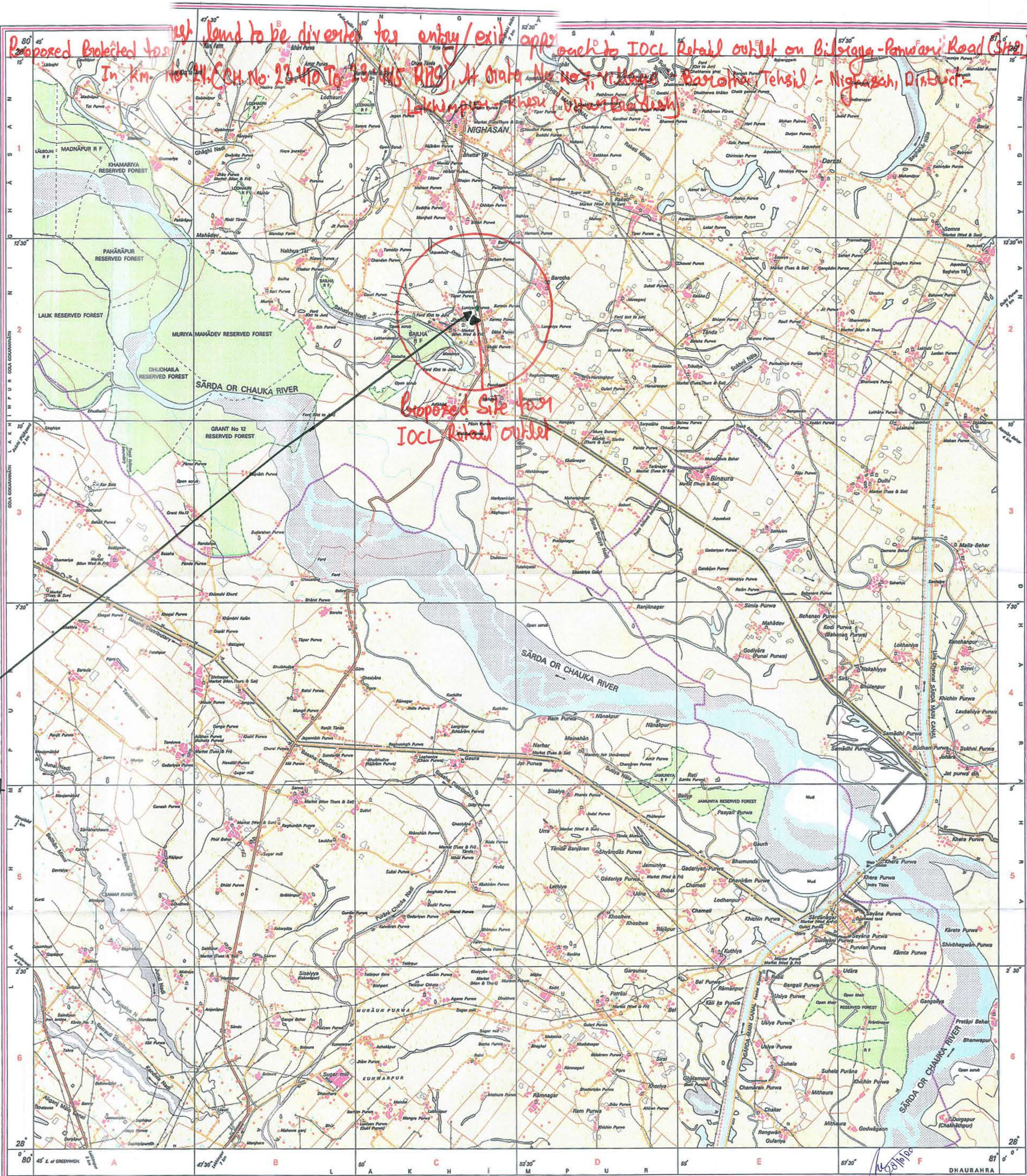
