Sub: - Diversion of 4.495 ha Forest land (RF-2.685 ha & Revenue Forest-1.810 ha) under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of 132 KV Power Transmission Line from Khuntuni to main Receiving Sub-Station (MRSS) of proposed Cement Plant at Chandrabalishyampur by Ms Odisha Cement Plant (Unit of Shree Cement Ltd) in the district of Cuttack under Athgarh Forest Division

Revised Demand to deposit of Rs.28,13,870 /- & Rs. 10,81,100/- towards the cost of NPV & compensatory Afforestation fund through e-payment mode.

Sir,

With reference to the above cited letters on the captioned subject, it is to inform you that the GOI, MOEF and CC, Eastern Regional Office A/3, Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar-751023 has conveyed the Stage-I/in principle approval for diversion of 4.495 ha Forest land (RF-2.685 Ha and Revenue Forest land -1.810 Ha) under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and guidelines in favour of M/s Odisha Cement Plant (A unit of Shree Cement Ltd) in the District of Cuttack under this division for construction of 132 KV power Transmission line from Khuntuni to Main Receiving Sub-Station (MRSS) of the proposed cement plant at Chandrabalishyampur subject to compliance of 27 nos conditions prescribed therein so as to consider the Stage-II final forest clearance of the above project. Besides as above the State Govt. of Odisha has imposed 6 nos additional conditions vide their Order No.16250/F&E dt. 19.10.2020 to be complied by the user agency respectively.

Hence as per stipulation of **condition No. vi** of GOI, MOEF and CC, the User Agency shall deposit the cost of NPV of the forest land to be diverted as per Order of the Supreme Court of India as well as guidelines issued by the Ministry contained in the conditions. Further as per **condition No.v** of the said order the C.A fund shall be deposited over 5.1 ha non-forest land as per the scheme technical approved by the PCCF, Nodal for the cost of raising and maintaining for 10 years.


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Accordingly the user agency has to deposit the cost of NPV and C.A fund in State CAMPA Fund through (<https://parivesh.nic.in>) as per generated e challan and submit the e-payment receipt pertaining to the above project in the prescribed CAMPA format to this office for taking further action at this level. The details of NPV and CA fund to be deposited by the User Agency is furnished below.


