The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways, canals and drains are shown in slant type, e.g. 5; whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 5.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Cart-roads and unmetalled roads along canals are motorable. Permission to use them is required from the Irrigation authorities. Unmetalled roads at other places are generally motorable in dry season.

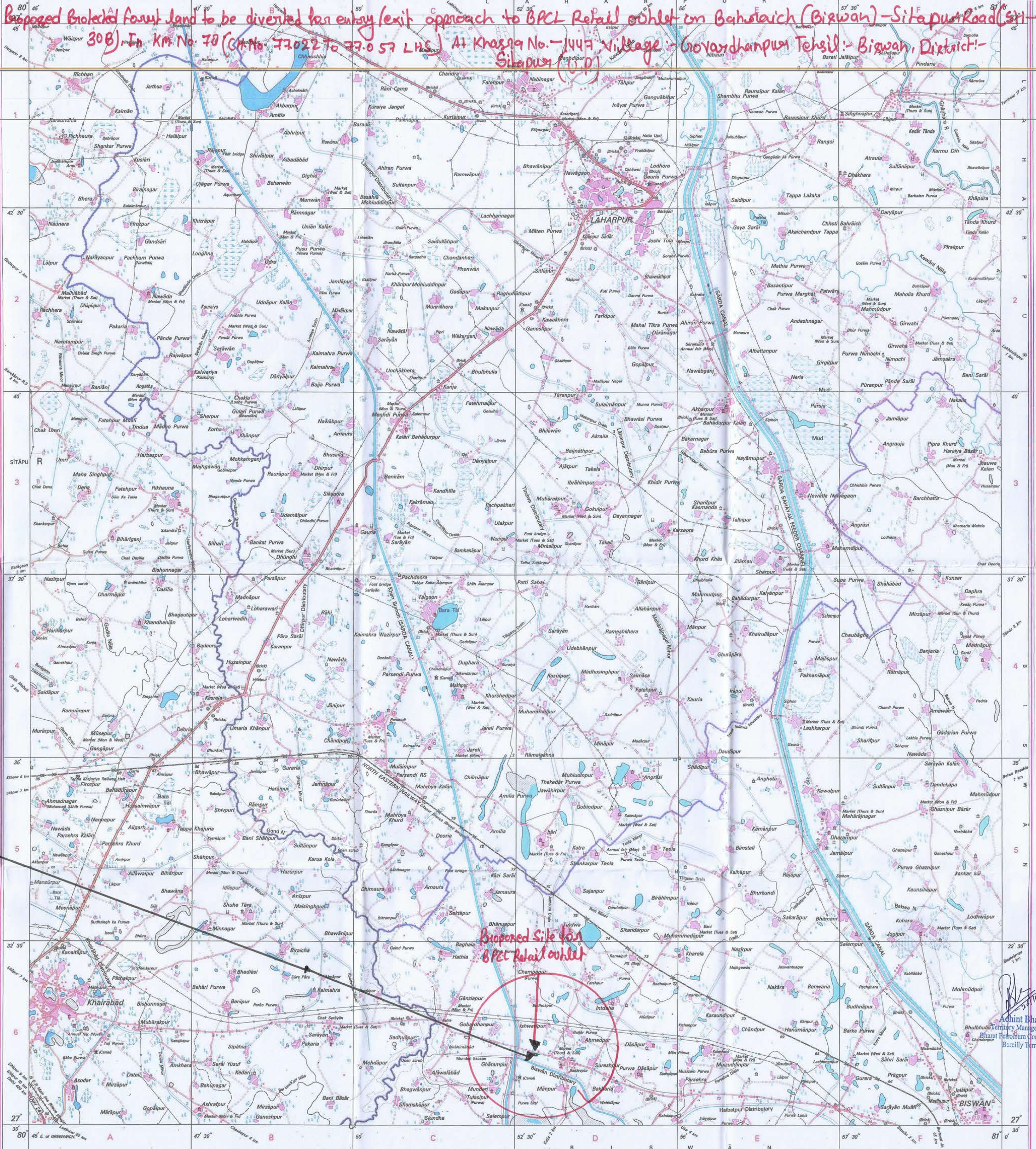
