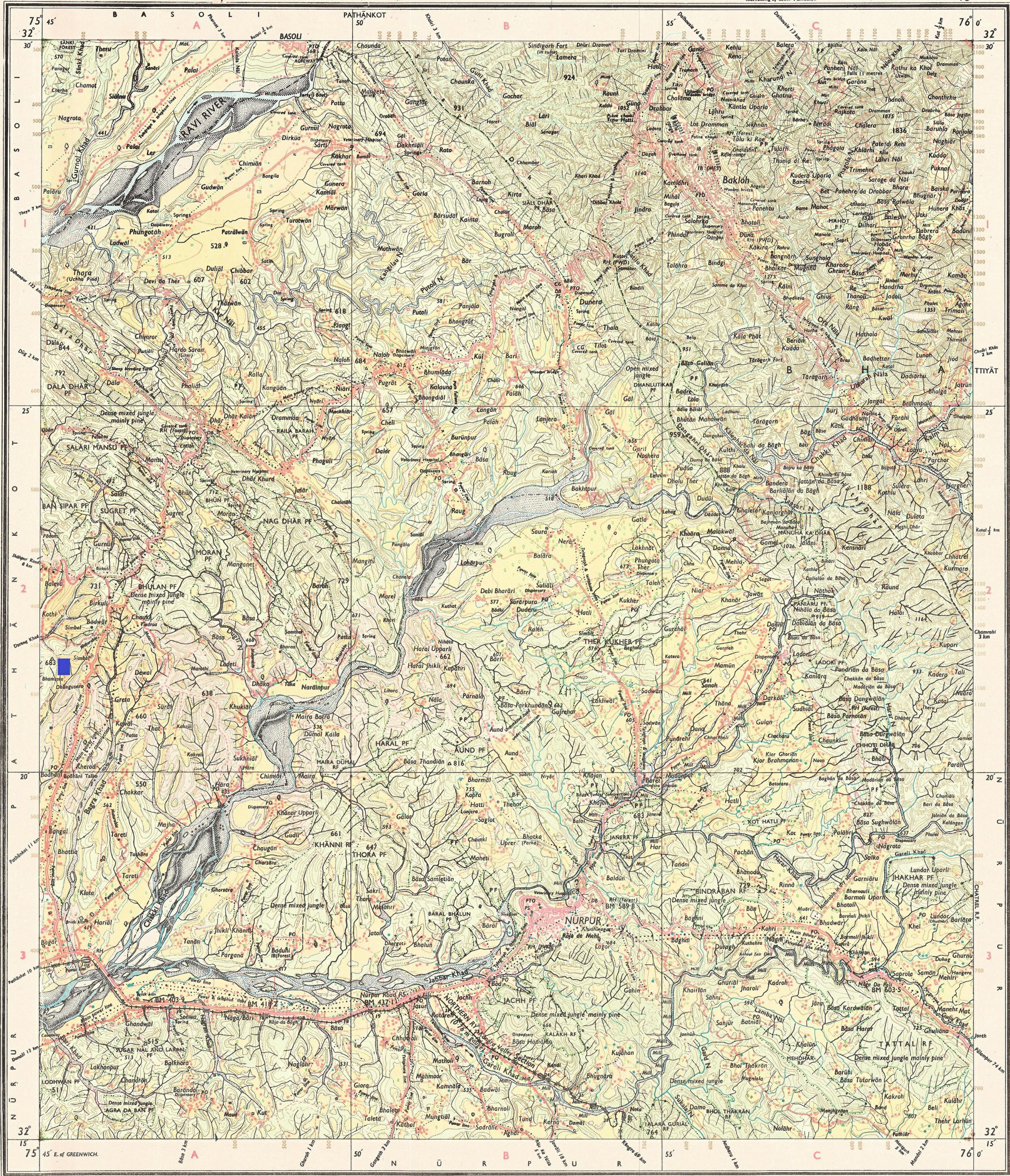

The triangulated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them. The sheet has been revised as a result of verification surveys in respect of roads, canals, power lines, telephone lines and other minor details carried out during 1973-74. Forest areas in Jammu & Kashmir are Government Reserves. The Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab and Himachal Pradesh Forest boundaries have been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground but have not been verified by the Governments concerned.

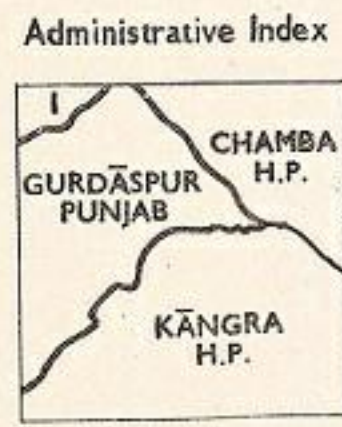

Contours are approximate. A relative height, δ r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope. Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.
